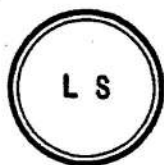

PREPAYMENT OF POSTAGE ON POSTAL ITEMS BY THE USE OF FRANKING METERS OR ORDINARY STAMPS

It is notified for your information that the present system whereby Federal and State Governments reimburse the Department of Posts and Telecommunications for the parcels and mails it carries on their behalf after assessing the amount due by sampling methods will be superseded with effect from the 1st day of October, 1968 by new arrangements which require that postage must be prepaid either by affixing stamps to letters or by the use of franking meters.

2. Sampling method is the system whereby in a year a two-week statistical count of posted Government mails and parcels is undertaken and the postage rate of the two-week figures multiplied by 26 to determine the amount chargeable to each Government in that particular year. This method does not represent an accurate and scientific method of determining the accurate charges, since the two-week count cannot be said to be representative of Government mail transactions with the Post Offices in a particular year. Consequently the sampling method is neither fair to Government Ministries/Departments nor to the Department of Posts and Telecommunications.

3. In order to enable a fairer assessment of charges on postages to be determined and to ensure that correct postage is paid and collected from all postal transactions, it has been decided to introduce the prepayment of postage on all correspondence by Government Ministries/Departments. IT IS TO BE EMPHASIZED THAT THE USE OF FRANKING METERS IS ONLY ALTERNATIVE TO AFFIXING POSTAGE STAMPS TO LETTERS. THEREFORE, ANY STATE THAT IS NOT PREPARED FOR THE USE OF FRANKING METERS BY THE 1ST DAY OF OCTOBER, 1968, SHOULD AFFIX ORDINARY POSTAGE STAMPS TO ITS LETTERS. WHAT IS OF CRUCIAL IMPORTANCE IN THE SCHEME IS THAT POSTAGE MUST BE PREPAID EITHER BY AFFIXING STAMPS TO LETTERS OR BY THE USE OF FRANKING METERS.

4. Franking postage meter machines are used under licence from the Director-General of Posts and Telecommunications to make one or more impressions on letters, etc., denoting the amount of postage prepaid and the place and date of posting. Before it is used, the machine is taken to a prescribed Post Office by the user and a sum paid to cover the number of units required. When impressions are made on the letter, etc., the amount expended in this way is registered on the meter in pounds, shillings and pence or in units. When the amount prepaid is expended, a fresh payment must be made and the meter re-set. The operation of the machine is very simple. The re-setting of the machines and the maintenance of record cards at Post Offices is a simple exercise which does not require a large staff. As a condition of sale, agents who sell franking machines are responsible for their maintenance and for issuing certificates of serviceability at least once a year to the effect that the machines are in good condition.

5. The use of franking machines, instead of other known methods such as sampling count, certification and use of special official postage stamps, is becoming increasingly popular with Government Departments and Commercial concerns in many countries because of the advantages it offers both in keeping accurate record of expenditure and in making accounting simpler.

6. Franking machines are sold by the firm of Messrs G. B. Ollivant Limited, Broad Street, Lagos, at £175-10s each. It is estimated that the average life of franking machines is ten years, which means that the capital out-lay of each Ministry/Department is not substantial. It is also recommended that letter scales should be bought along with the franking meters to facilitate the determination of postage due on every item intended for the post. These letter scales No. 159P are also obtainable from Messrs G. B. Ollivant Limited, Broad Street, Lagos, at a cost of about £4-10s each and they are already fixed with graduated rings showing postage rates for :

- (a) inland letters,
- (b) foreign letters by surface mails,
- (c) letters by surface mails to O.A.U. countries ; and
- (d) inland printed papers.

The scales can weigh items ranging from $\frac{1}{2}$ oz-5 lbs.

7. The Federal Ministry of Finance has agreed to insert a provision under the Ministry of Trade's Head of expenditure for the purchase of franking machines and letter scales required by all Federal Ministries and Extra-Ministerial Departments. Authority to incur expenditure from the Internal and Telegraphs Services vote under the Ministry of Finance's Head of expenditure would also be issued from time to time to Ministries and Departments to meet their postage costs during the 1968-69 financial year. It is expected that all State Governments will make similar arrangements for their Ministries and Departments.

8. The Territorial/Area Controllers in Posts and Telecommunications Territories and Areas will contact Secretaries to State Military Governments or their nominees with a view to explaining the advantages of the new system and to evolve a plan for its introduction.
