THE CONSTITUTION OF WESTERN STATE

As modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967

> By His Excellency Major-General YAKUBU GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.



MAJOR-GENERAL YAKUBU GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces

WHEREAS by section 48 (2) of the Constitution of Western State as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967, it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of Western State shall consist of the Chief Justice of Western State and such number of other Judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law :

AND WHEREAS by section 49 (4) of the Constitution of Western State as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967, it is provided that if the office of any judge of the High Court of the State other than the Chief Justice is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Chief Justice or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law to act in the office of a judge of the High Court and any person so appointed shall continue to act for the period of his appointment or if no period is specified until his appointment is revoked by the Supreme Military Council acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee.

Now THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee has appointed OLUFEMI ODUNLAMI to act as a Judge of the High Court of Western State from the 20th day of June, 1968.
