5. promote the implementation of the Universal Copyright Convention and the International Convention for the Protection of Performers, Producers of Phonograms and Broadcasting Organizations, and conduct the negotiations at government level arising from these conventions.

6. act as Secretary of the Intergovernmental Copyright Committee.

7. for these purposes, keep abreast of current activities in the copyright field and keep in touch with governments, intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations.

8. advise other Departments on matters pertaining to copyright.

9. carry out any other tasks which may be assigned to the Division.

Qualifications and experience required.—(a) good university degree in law;

(b) specialization in copyright problems, involving sufficient knowledge of Code Law, Common Law and Socialist Law ideas on the subject to direct and supervise the work of the Section, and a thorough knowledge of one of these three systems on which he would do independent work;
