## THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FORMER EASTERN NIGERIA

As modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967



By His Excellency Major-General Yakubu Gowon, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

MAJOR-GENERAL YAKUBU GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces

Whereas by section 50 (2) of the Constitution of the former Eastern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the High Court of the former Eastern Nigeria shall consist of the Chief Justice and such number of other judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 51 (1) of the Constitution of the former Eastern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967, it is provided that the Chief Justice and the other judges of the High Court shall be appointed by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee:

Now Therefore, The Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee do hereby appoint Peter Effiong Odo Bassey a Judge of the South-Eastern State with effect from 12th August, 1968.
