DUTY-FREE CLEARANCE OF GOODS FOR THE DIPLOMATIC CORPS

Commencement: 4th November, 1968

Notes:

- 1. The Forms referred to in this Notice (See Annexes "A" and "B") may be obtained from the Protoco Division of the Ministry of External Affairs.
- 2. This Notice covers all imported goods whether imported direct or delivered from a bonded warehouse and all excisable goods.
 - 3. It also covers motor vehicles purchased from duty-paid stock of motor dealers.
- 1. General.—All requests for duty-free clearance of imported or excisable goods for the Diplomatic Corps should be made through the Protocol Division of the Ministry of External Affairs.
- 2. Preparation of requests.—(a) Requests for duty-free clearance of goods other than alcoholic beverages are to be made on Form CC-1.
 - (b) Requests for duty-free clearance of alcoholic beverages are to be made on Form CC-2.
- (c) Forms CC-1 and CC-2 are to be completed in quadruplicate, the quadruplicate copy being retained by the diplomatic mission.
- 3. Signatures to requests.—All forms CC-1 and CC-2 are to be signed by the Head of Mission or by his authorised representative. Specimen signatures of the Head of Mission and if appropriate, his authorised representative are to be lodged with the Protocol Division.
- 4. Transmission of requests.—Three copies (i.e., original, duplicate and triplicate) of all requests on Forms CC-1 and CC-2 are to be addressed to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of External Affairs, for the attention of the Chief of Protocol.
- 5. Action by Chief of Protocol.—(a) The Chief of Protocol will examine all requests on Forms CC-1 and CC-2. If he is satisfied as to the eligibility of the requests, he will forward the original and duplicate of each form (except request for purchase of Motor Vehicles from duty-paid stock) to the Area Chief Collector, Customs and Excise with a recommendation that the goods be released as requested.
- (b) In respect of requests for purchase of Motor Vehicles from duty-paid stock, the original and duplicate of Form CC-1 will be forwarded to the Chief Collector, Mosaic House, Lagos for issue of replacement authorisation. Motor dealers under the contract of sale of the motor vehicle must lodge application to import replacement vehicles at the same time.
- 6. Action by the Customs and Excise.—The proper Area Chief Collector will examine the request and if satisfied as to the particulars stated will forward the original of the Form to the appropriate Company or clearing agent for presentation to the proper officer at the time of clearance of the goods.
- 7. In respect of Motor Vehicles to be purchased from duty-paid stock, the Chief Collector, Mosaic House, Lagos will, on receipt of the completed Form CC-1, examine the request and give approval as he considers appropriate. The Chief Collector will then forward to the applicant the original of the Form, two copies of the Vehicle Replacement Authorisation and the Entry for presentation to the Cashier at the Ingate.
