

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERATION

As modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967



By His Excellency Major-General YAKUBU GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

MAJOR-GENERAL YAKUBU GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces

Whereas by section 111 (2) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the Judges of the Supreme Court of Nigeria shall consist of the Chief Justice of Nigeria and any such number of Justices of the Supreme Court (not being less than five) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 112 (4) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that if the office of any Justice of the Supreme Court is vacant or if the person holding the office is for any reason unable to perform the functions of the office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person qualified to hold the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court to act in the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court, and any person so appointed shall continue to act for the period of the appointment.

Now therefore, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint Mr Justice Fatayi-Williams of the Western State Court of Appeal to act as a Justice of the Supreme Court from 2nd December to 10th December, 1968.

- (i) Higher School Certificate with three principal passes on one occasion or four on two occasions, one principal pass being Mathematics or a Science subjects (preferably Physics).
- (ii) General Certificate of Education with three passes at Advanced Level on one occasion or four passes at Advance Level on two occasions, one of the passes at Advanced Level being Mathematics or a Science subject (preferably Physics) or
- (iii) University Intermediate Degree with a pass in Mathematics or a Science subject (preferably Physics).

Confirmed candidates in Government service with a minimum of five years service and who obtained not less than credits in one West African School Certificate or G.C.E. (O/L) in the following subjects and who are recommended by their Heads of Departments will be considered: Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, English Language.

Medical requirements.—The medical fitness of candidates will be assessed on the basis of the following International Civil Aviation Organisation medical requirements:—

- (i) Physical requirement.—A Candidate shall be required to have no history of significant mental or nervous trouble, should be free from any mental impairement, or presumptive evidence of latent or nervous trouble, should be free from any mental impairement, or presumptive evidence of latent epilepsy and not suffer from any disease or disability which renders him liable suddenly to become unable to perform his duties safely.
- (ii) Visual requirement.—The candidates shall be required to demonstrate his ability to perceive readily those colours the perception of which is necessary for the safe performance of his duties.
- (iii) Hearing requirement.—The candidates shall be required to be free from any hearing defect which would interfere with the efficient performance of his duties. He should normally be able to hear an average conversational voice in a quiet room using both ears at a distance of eight feet from the speaker and with his back turned to him.

Training.—Successful candidates will be required to undergo an initial training at Lagos Airport to familiarise them with some of the equipment and terminologies used in Aviation. This is followed by a more advanced course which is provided either at the Civil Aviation Training Centre, Zaria or at a recognised institution overseas. During this second phase of the training, candidates are required to undergo practical flying training course.

On successful completion of these trainings candidates will undergo a further period of on-the-job practical training and the successful ones will be eligible for appointment as Air Traffic Control Officers, Grade III, on salary Scale B1—£690-36-762-102-864-36-900. The normal period of training extends over a period of 3 years.

Duties.—The duties of an Air Traffic Control Officer consist of the exercise of the Control of Air Traffic together with the associated Search and Rescue and Flight Information Services.

Prospects.—Prospects of promotion to the following grades exist in the Ministry:—

- (i) Air Traffic Control Officer, Grade II, Scale B2, 3—(£936-1,314).
- (ii) Air Traffic Control Officer, Grade I, Scale B4 (£1,368-1,584).
- (iii) Senior Air Traffic Control Officer, Group 9 (£1,728).
- (iv) Chief Air Traffic Control Officer, Group 7 (£2,292).
- (v) Controller of Ground Services, Group 6 (£2,496).
