## THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERATION

AS MODIFIED BY THE CONSTITUTION (SUSPENSION AND MODIFICATION) DECREE 1966 AND THE STATES (CREATION AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS) DECREE 1967



By His Excellency Major-General YAKUBU GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

WHEREAS by section 111 (2) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the Judges of the Supreme Court of Nigeria shall consist of the Chief Justice of Nigeria and any such number of Justices of the Supreme Court (not being less than five) as may be prescribed by law :

AND WHEREAS by section 112 (4) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that if the office of any Justice of the Supreme Court is vacant or if the person holding the office is for any reason unable to perform the functions of the office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person qualified to hold the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court to act in the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court, and any person so appointed shall continue to act for the period of the appointment.

NOW THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint MR JUSTICE FATAYI-WILLIAMS of the Western State Court of Appeal to act as a Justice of the Supreme Court from 2nd December to 10th December, 1968.
