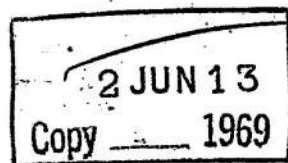

7. Expatriate firms wishing to tender should indicate whether or not their companies are established in Nigeria in accordance with the Immigration Act.

8. Tenders will also not be considered unless submitted on the official tender forms in envelopes or packages marked "Confidential—Tenders for the Supply of Petroleum Products", sealed with sealing wax, and addressed to the Secretary, Federal Tenders Board, Federal Ministry of Works and Housing, Awolowo Road, Lagos, so as to reach him not later than 12 noon on Saturday, 8th February, 1969.
