The National Technical Teacher Training College is a new Federal Government institution which was opened in October 1967 for the training of technical teachers. It is a joint project with UNESCO and United Nations Development Programme.

The next intake of students will be in September 1969 and applications for admission are invited from suitably qualified candidates throughout the Federation.

2. Courses of Study.—Two types of courses are offered at the College:—

(a) A one academic year (ten months) course for those already qualified in their various technical fields but lack pedagogical training. The course

is open to "pre-service/and "in-service" candidates. The entry qualification for the one year course will depend on whether the trainee is to teach at a trade centre or vocational schools, technical college or commercial institution.

Candidates for training as teachers in trade centres or vocational schools must possess the Advanced Craft (Final) or Full Technological Certificate of City and Guilds in an appropriate craft, together with a minimum of two years approved industrial experience. Suitable teaching experience may be accepted in lieu of industrial experience in the case of "in-service" candidates.

Candidates for training as teachers in technical colleges in the fields of Engineering and Building must possess any one of the following qualifications:

A University degree,

Higher National Diploma or Certificate,

Higher Certificate of City and Guilds or

Higher Diploma of Yaba College of Technology.

or other acceptable qualification in Civil, Mechanical, or Electrical Engineering or Building, together with relevant experience.

Commerce candidates must possess either a degree in Commerce or the Higher National Diploma or Certificate in Business Studies, or the A.C.C.S. or A.C.I.S. or other acceptable qualification together with relevant experience.

Candidate for training as teachers of Stenography must possess the West African School Certificate with at least a credit in English, or equivalent qualification, together with recognised advanced certificates in Shorthand and Typewriting ((120/50) w.p.m. minimum) and suitable office or teaching experience.

(b) A three-year course involving technical and pedagogical training to prepare candidates as technical teachers in secondary schools. The standard of the course would be equivalent to the present Nigerian Certificate in Education (N.C.E.) course but would have a technical bias. The subjects of the course would include Applied Science, Woodwork, Metalwork and Technical Drawing together with pedagogy and other related subjects.

The necessary entry qualification is the West African School Certificate with credits in four subjects including English, Mathematics and Science (Physics, Chemistry or Physics with Chemistry).

3. Conditions of training.—

(a) Successful Nigerian candidates will be eligible for free board and tuition.

(b) All students will be required to pay Students' Union Fees of £2 per annum for the duration of their course.

(c) Selection of candidates for the one-year course will be by interview. For the three-year course, selection may be by entrance examination and interview.

(d) Preference will be given to sponsored candidates.

BUILDING AND ENGINEERING (HIGHER)

Two-year courses open only to those who have:—

Two-year courses open only to those who have one or both of the following qualifications :—

- (a) a West African School Certificate with a pass in English language, and credits in Mathematics, Physics (or Physics-with-Chemistry), and one other suitable subject,
- or (b) a General Certificate of Education with passes at Ordinary level in four subjects listed in (a) above.

Applicants must state the precise course required (Building, Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering or Quantity surveying).

The successful completion of one of these courses entitles the student to the award of the Yaba Diploma and, with the exception of students of Quantity Surveying, to entry to the Ordinary Technician Diploma examinations of C.G.L.I. Quantity Surveying students are adequately prepared for the intermediate examination of the Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors or the Institute of Quantity Surveyors.

LABORATORY TECHNICIAN (ADVANCED)

A two-year course leading to the Advanced Certificate of the City and Guilds of London Institute (Course 119) which is recognised by the Institute of Science Technology as an examination qualification for Associate Membership, and to the Yaba Higher Diploma.

Initially the course will be offered in the Techniques of Chemistry, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Physics and General Laboratory Techniques.

Applicants proposing to take the City and Guilds Certificate examination will normally be expected to have passed the examination for the Science Laboratory Technician's Ordinary Certificate.

Other candidates, as indicated in the appropriate City and Guilds of London Institute regulations, as well as any candidate for the College Diploma only, will have to satisfy the College authorities, in an entrance examination, to indicate their competence in the Laboratory Methods and Equipment section of the syllabus for the Ordinary Certificate.

LABORATORY TECHNICIAN (ORDINARY)

A two-year course leading to the Science Laboratory Technician's examination of C.G.L.I. and to the Yaba Diploma. Applicants should possess a West African School Certificate with credits in Mathematics and two Science subjects.

GENERAL ART

A two-year intermediate level course in the various departments of Fine and Commercial Arts and Crafts. Candidates must possess a West African School Certificate, or equivalent with credits in Art and two other subjects, and a pass in English language. It is necessary for candidates to show evidence of artistic aptitude.

COMMERCIAL ART

A two-year course designed to produce Studio Assistants for Advertising and similar trades leading to the award of the Yaba Diploma. Candidates must possess a West African School Certificate or equivalent, with credits in Art and two other subjects, and a pass in English language. It is necessary for candidates to show evidence of artistic aptitude.

FASHION DESIGN

A three-year course in Fashion Design open to those having a good general education at least to Secondary School Leaving Certificate level. Special aptitude for this subject will be taken into consideration. This course will lead to the award of the Yaba Certificate.

PRINTING

A four-year course open to holders of Secondary Class IV certificates, giving vocational training in Compositor's Work and Letterpress Machine Printing, leading to the award of the Yaba Certificate and in certain cases to the appropriate examinations of C.G.L.I. Selection is by competitive examination, preference being given to candidates who have studied Physics, Chemistry or Physics with Chemistry.

HORLOGY (WATCH REPAIRING)

A three-year course giving vocational training in Watch Repairing, open to holders of Secondary Class IV Certificates, and leading to the award of the Yaba Certificate in Watch Repairing. Preference will be given to those who have obtained West African School Certificate in Mathematics and English. Admission will be through aptitude and intelligence tests to be conducted by West African Examinations Council.

ACCOUNTANCY

A two-year course open to those who have obtained the West African School Certificate with credits in at least five subjects including English or English Literature and Mathematics or its equivalents as listed in the A.C.C.A. regulations.

This course prepares students for the Sections I and II of the A.C.C.A. and for the College Diploma which is awarded on successful completion of the course.

SECRETARYSHIP
