- 1. Title of post.—Lecturer in Extension Department (In-service Teacher Training).
  - 2. Location.-Kabul, Afghanistan.
- 3. Background and functions.—During the second Five-Year Plan for the economic and social development of Afghanistan, the Government, with the financial assistance of the United Nations Special Fund and with UNESCO as the Excuting Agency, established in 1964 a co-educational Higher Teachers' College for training of teachers for middle schools, i.e., Grades 7, 8 and 9.

The College is providing a two-year course of studies in, (a) a selected group of subjects related to the programme of the middle schools and (b) professional subjects leading to the award, to those successfully completing the course, of a Diploma of Teaching (Middle Schools).

Originally the project was planned to end in 1969 after an operational period of six years. In 1968, after the commencement of the Third Five Year Plan, the Government requested and the UNDP agreed that a further two years should be added to the project life which now extends to 1971.

During this time, the Higher Teachers' College staff will work very closely with the Regional Educational Development Project which seeks to extend assistance in many fields of education in the provinces. One new Higher Teachers' College department has been established in Kandahar in 1968; and another is planned for Mazar-i-Sharif in 1969.

Under the supervision of the Senior Expert, who is the head of the team, the expert will be required:

- (a) To organize and implement in-service courses for teachers who enter the College on a part time basis.
- (b) To plan follow-up work with graduate students of the College.
- (c) To work in close contact with all the College lecturers.
- (d) To train Afghan personnel in all aspects of in-service and follow-up procedure.
- (e) To work in close co-operation with the Regional Educational Development Project.
- (f) To prepare lists of equipment and books or materials provided for the Project.
- (g) To prepare progress reports required by Unesco and the Special Fund.
- (h) To carry out such duties as may be assigned to him, on an ad hoc basis, by the Secretarial, (Headquarters) and the Chief Technical Adviser, which are considered necessary for the execution of the Project.

- 4. Qualifications.—A University Degree in Education or a degree plus a diploma in education, or an equivalent qualification. The applicant should be acquainted with recent developments in methods of teaching should be active and should have had experience in a teachers' training college. Experience of work in developing countries will be an asset.
  - 5. Language.—English.
