By an agreement dated the 19th day of February, 1965, and made between the Federal Republic of Nigeria (hereinafter referred to as "the Government") and the Defendant, the Government guaranteed a loan of One thousand and twenty-five pounds (£1,025) granted to the Defendant by the United Dominion Corporation (Nigeria) Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") under a hirepurchase agreement between the Defendant and the Company.
- 4. It was a condition of the said agreement that the Government would by the default of the Defendant become liable to pay to the Company any outstanding amount of the loan and interest thereon, and thereafter the Government would succeed to all rights and powers of the Company under the hirepurchase agreement.
- 5. The Defendant subsequently defaulted under the hire-purchase agreement with the Company and the Company thereupon called on the Government to pay the sum of £504-11s-4d which sum represented the balance outstanding against the Defendant at the time of the default.
- 6. The Government has paid the said sum of £504-11s-4d to the Company.
- 7. The Plaintiff is therefore entitled to claim the said sum of £504-11s-4d from the Defendant.
- 8. The Defendant has failed to pay the said sum of £504-11s-4d or any part thereof in spite of repeated demands.
- 9. Wherefore the Plaintiff claims the said sum of £504-11s-4d.
