for the production of edible salt based on the importation of crude salt for local refinery at two major ports, each with a maximum tonnage of 75,000 tons per annum under the following terms:—

BUREAU FOR EXTERNAL AID FOR EDUCATION  
OVERSEAS SCHOLARSHIPS—1971

*Policy.*—It is the policy of the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria to accept scholarships outside Nigeria at institutions of Higher learning that will provide supplementary facilities to those available in this country and which will support its high-level manpower policy.

During the course of the year, scholarship offers are made to Nigeria by various foreign governments and organisations. Whether these scholarships are made direct to the Nigerian Government or to Organisations and private individuals in this country, all offers shall as a matter of policy be made to the Nigerian Government in the first instance. The offer is received on behalf of the Nigerian Government by the Ministry of External Affairs for evaluation and processing.

*Fields.*—In support of this policy, Overseas Scholarships are expected to be made available in all branches of study at the post-graduate level, and primarily in the following fields of study at the undergraduate level :

*Basic qualification.*—Candidates for undergraduate awards must have a good basic secondary education leading to the West African School Certificate or

Candidates with at least two Advanced Level Papers in relevant subjects would be at advantage. Candidates with approved technical qualifications such as those of City and Guilds of London Institute and who show evidence of practical experience may apply for vocational and advanced technical scholarships.

Candidates for post-graduate awards must have received a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent. Preference will be given to those who have worked or one or two years after their first degree.

*Method of application.*—Candidates wishing to be considered for any foreign scholarship for the year 1971 must apply for application forms which include general information and instructions, from: the Ministries of Education in the states; the Secretary, Federal Scholarship Board, P.M.B. 12573, Lagos; Nigerian Embassy and Consulate Offices Overseas; as well as from the Secretary, Bureau for External Aid for Education, P.M.B. 12013, Lagos.
