10½-INCH O.D. PIPELINE

Notice is hereby given in accordance with section 4 of the Oil Pipelines Act 1965 that Mobil Producing Nigeria whose registered office is at 1-5 Odunlami Street, Lagos has applied to the Federal Ministry of Mines and Power for the right to enter upon, take possession of and use for a period of twenty (20) years a strip of land on the Continental Shelf and underneath the waters thereof for the purpose of laying a 10½-inch outside diameter welded steel pipeline from the Etim "A" Well Platform to the Etim Production Platform both of which are located in OML-67.

DESCRIPTION

I. ACCEPTANCE OF CANDIDATES

1. The examination is open to candidates at present in attendance at Secondary Grammar Schools in the Federation of Nigeria who are taking their West African School Certificate in 1971 and whose Principals are prepared to certify:—

(a) that the applicants' school records indicate that they are likely to gain a Grade I or Grade II School Certificate;

(b) that the candidates possess all the personal qualities needed to ensure success in a Sixth Form course;

(c) that such candidates will undertake to complete the course.

2. Principals are requested to enter ONLY candidates in respect of whom they can conscientiously certify as in (a), (b) and (c) above.

3. In the case of boys, only five applicants may be entered. The number of girls to be entered is not restricted. (In mixed schools, five boys and any girl who qualifies may be entered).

II. GENERAL ARRANGEMENTS

1. Dates

(a) Closing date of entry (return of all application forms)—8th February, 1971.

(b) Dates of entrance examination—30th and 31st March, and 1st April.

2. *Examination Centres.*—The examination will be taken at the candidates' school under the strict supervision of the Principal or his nominee, who has responsibility for the conduct of the examination at the School Centre.

III. PROCEDURE FOR ENTRY

(a) Application forms and further detailed information should be obtained, in the case of schools presenting candidates for this examination for the first time, as follows:—

(i) Principals of Lagos State Schools and Schools in the East-Central State, Rivers and South-Eastern States wishing to enter candidates should obtain application forms and information from the Principal of King's College, Lagos.

(ii) Principals of schools in the Western State should obtain such forms and information from the Principal Queen's College, Lagos.

(iii) Principals of schools in the Mid-Western and Kwara States should obtain forms and information from the Principal, Federal Government College, Warri.

(iv) Principals of schools in the North-Western, North-Central, Kano, North-Eastern and Benue-Plateau States should obtain forms and information from the Principal, Federal Government College, Sokoto.

(b) In the case of schools which presented candidates for this examination in 1970, application forms and information will be sent for the 1971 examination without further demand. Such schools whose addresses have changed should notify the respective centres from which they should receive forms and papers as in (a) above. Any such schools which have received no forms by mid-January should request them.

(c) As in the past, each school will be responsible for incidental costs incurred in administering this examination on behalf of its candidates at the school centre.

Commencement : 20th April, 1970

Law.—The attention of importers and their Agents is drawn to the provisions of Tariff No. 33.06B of Schedule 1 to the Customs Tariff Act 1965 No. 3.

2. The conditions under which medicated dusting powders may be imported and accepted by the Board for entry at the lower rate of duty of 33½ per cent *ad valorem* are as follows :—

- (a) approval by the Board, in respect of each brand, prior to importation ;
- (b) a minimum content of 10 per cent, by weight, of medicinal substances of recognised efficacy except that, in special cases where particularly effective drugs are used, a smaller percentage may be accepted at the Board's discretion ;
- (c) advertisement and sale as a medicated dusting powder ; and
- (d) importation in containers :
 - (i) showing the formula used, and
 - (ii) boldly labelled "Medicated Dusting Powder".

3. This Notice supersedes Government Notice No. 951 published in *Official Gazette* No. 40 of 6th May, 1965 which is hereby cancelled.
