WHEREAS MOHAMED ABBAS SIDI, having been duly convicted of diverse offences was sentenced to imprisonment for a term of seven years with effect from 31st October, 1970:

AND WHEREAS the Supreme Military Council, after reviewing his case, is pleased to remit the remainder of the term of imprisonment imposed on him:

Now THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 101 (1) of the Constitution of the Federation and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Supreme Military Council do hereby as from the date hereunder grant the aforesaid Mohamed Abbas Sidi a remission of the remainder of the said term of imprisonment.
