Whereas by section 111 (2) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 it is provided that the Judges of the Supreme Court of Nigeria shall be the Chief Justice of Nigeria and such number of Justices of the Supreme Court (not being less than five) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 112 (4) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 it is provided that if the office of any Justice of the Supreme Court is vacant or if the person holding the office is for any reason unable to perform the functions of the office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person qualified to hold the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court to act in the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court.

Now THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint MR JUSTICE GEORGE SODEINDE SOWEMIMO to act as a Justice of the Supreme Court with effect from 25th January 1971.

WHEREAS a Trade Dispute between the Association of Aircraft Technicians of Nigeria Airways Limited and the Nigeria Airways Limited has been apprehended by me in accordance with the powers conferred upon me by section 5 (2) of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) Decree No. 21 of 1968 and a trade dispute now exists between the aforesaid parties;

AND WHEREAS both parties have been informed of my apprehension and of the steps which I propose to take for the purpose of resolving the dispute;

- (i) Conditions of Service;
- (ii) Salary structure for Engineering Junior Staff;
- (iii) Fringe benefits with regard to General Orders 22103 and 22104, purchase of bicycles and motor cycles, and housing allowance;
 - (iv) Job evaluation report and payment of arrears;
 - (v) Extension of medical facilities;
 - (vi) Returnees;
 - (vii) Automatic application of increments;
 - (viii) Training facilities for existing staff and the question of the 12 trainees with Air Lingus;
 - (ix) 1969-70 to 70-71 Promotions;
 - (x) Representation on the Insurance Board and release of annual individual contribution;

(xi) Shift allowance figures;

(xii) Removal of Mr D. A. Adebiyi as the Personnel Manager of the Nigeria Airways Limited;

(xiii) Removal of Mr L. L. T. Lawson as the Engineering Manager of the Nigeria Airways Limited;

(xiv) Improvement in the water supply system in the Nigeria Airways Limited;

- 4. (a) Method of application.—Candidates who want application forms sent to them by post should forward to this Ministry, self-addressed envelopes marked "Scholarship GWN 1970" in the left hand corner. Every prospective candidate is required to fill only one copy of the application form.
- (b) Completed application forms must be returned direct to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education, (Students' Division), Ibadan, through Heads of Departments in case of Government employees and in other cases through Principals of Schools and Colleges or through employers as appropriate, and should be received in this Ministry not later than 15th March, 1971.
- (c) In the case of overseas candidates, application forms should be returned to the London Office, addressed to Education Attaché, Nigeria High Commission, 178/202 Great Portland Street, London, W.1.
- 5. Applicants for degree courses must possess the General Certificate of Education (Advanced Level), in at least two subjects passed at one sitting and relevant to the course of study proposed by the candidate or two passes at the principal level in the Higher School Certificate in related subjects. In addition, applicants must have credit in English at the West African School Certificate or a pass in English in the General Certificate of Education.

Applicants for non-graduate and technical courses must possess at least the West African School Certificate Grade I or Grade II or its equivalent (with credits in English and Science subjects for technical courses) or the relevant professional qualification for entry into the proposed course of study.

- 6. Post-Graduate.—Applicants for post-graduate degrees must have obtained first or second class honours in their first degrees except in such courses where examination results are not graded, for example, Medicine.
- 7. Admission.—In addition to submitting application forms, candidates are expected to apply for admission direct to institutions of their choice. Where applicants for courses tenable overseas fail to secure admission, they will be assisted by the Ministry provided they gain awards. In the cases of successful candidates who produce evidence of admission to overseas institutions, the Scholarship Board would confirm such admission through the Nigeria High Commission, London, or the appropriate Embassy in the country concerned.
- 8. Photostat copies of certificates must be attached to the application forms and these may be retained for the use of the Scholarship Selection Board. As this office will not be responsible for the loss of any original certificates, candidates are advised not to forward them at the initial stage.
