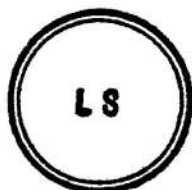

WHEREAS by section 111 (2) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 it is provided that the Judges of the Supreme Court of Nigeria shall be the Chief Justice of Nigeria and such number of Justices of the Supreme Court (not being less than five) as may be prescribed by law :

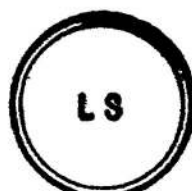
AND WHEREAS by section 112 (4) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 it is provided that if the office of any Justice of the Supreme Court is vacant or if the person holding the office is for any reason unable to perform the functions of the office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person qualified to hold the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court to act in the office of a Justice of the Supreme Court.

NOW THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint MR JUSTICE GEORGE SOBEINDE SOWEMIMO to act as a Justice of the Supreme Court with effect from 25th January 1971.

AND WHEREAS by section 49 (3) of the Constitution of the Mid-Western State modified as aforesaid it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the High Court other than the Chief Justice is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Chief Justice or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law to act in the office of a Judge of the High Court :

AND WHEREAS by section 51 (4) of the Constitution of the former Eastern Nigeria modified as aforesaid it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the High Court other than the Chief Justice is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Chief Justice or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law to act in the office of a Judge of the High Court :
