In addition to the Project Manager, four instructors will be recruited internationally. Provision is also made for consultant services. Study fellowships will be granted to counterpart instructors.

Besides teaching materials, the Special Fund will provide laboratory equipment and equipment for the obtainment, transmission and processing of data.
