#### BOARD OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

## LIST OF THE LICENSED CUSTOMS AGENTS FOR 1971 (Under Section 138 of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1958)

Pursuant to section 138 of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1958 and the powers conferred on the Board of Customs and Excise by regulation 5 of the Customs and Excise Customs Agents (Licensing) Regulations 1968, the Board has granted Customs Agents Licences for the year 1971 to the persons whose 'names are shown in column 2 of the subjoined list.

- 2. Any person licensed as a Customs Agent is authorised to transact any business relating to Customs with an officer on behalf of another person. His duties include clearing and forwarding on behalf of importers or exporters in accordance with Customs Laws and Regulations. An agent may also submit application to the Board on behalf of an importer or an exporter for any refund of duty due to such importer or exporter where the Agent had paid the duty on behalf of the importer or exporter.
- 3. Any Customs Agent who acts as an agent of an importer or exporter of goods is personally liable for the payment of any duties payable in respect of those goods and for the performance of all acts under the Customs and Excise laws in relation to those goods, but the importer or exporter is not relieved of his liability under the Customs and Excise Laws.
- 4. Customs Agents are warned that it is a condition of their licence that they shall faithfully and uncorruptly perform their duties in an efficient manner to the satisfaction of the Board and that the licence of any customs agent who in the opinion of the Board fails to observe such conditions is liable to immediate cancellation and his security may be forfeited to the Board.
- 5. A Customs Agent Licence is not transferrable and the Board may revoke the licence of any Customs Agent for the contravention of Customs Laws and Regulations.
- Every Licensed Customs Agent is required to publish at Customs Houses his table of rates to be charged for services rendered or to be rendered by him as customs Agent to the public.

## BOARDING OF SHIPS, AIRCRAFTS AND VEHICLES AND INWARD REPORT AMENDMENT No. 2

Customs and Excise Notice No. 5 published as Government Notice No. 1149 of 1969 in the Federation of Nigeria Official Gazette No. 41 of 31st July, 1969 is hereby amended.

By deleting paragraph 27 and substituting new paragraph 27 as hereunder:

#### 27. FISHING BOATS-

- (a) Owners or agents of every fishing boat must give at least six hours prior notice to the proper Collector of Customs and Excise, of the arrival of such vessel.
- (b) The master or his agent must make a report of the arrival and sailing of such boat and must at the earliest opportunity produce documentary evidence of registration under the Merchant Shipping Act 1962, No. 30.
  - (c) All fishing boats must be boarded by officer of Customs and Excise.
- (d) All owners/agents of fishing boats operating in Nigeria, whether or not the fishing boats are Nigerian-owned, registered in Nigeria, or on charter, are required to register with the Board and furnish a list of their vessels.
- (e) A standard log book as prescribed by the Ministry of Transport is to be kept by every master of a fishing boat. The log book must indicate clearly the extent of the voyage (including ports of call if any), period spent outside ports and the average gross weight of the catches.
- (f) Where a fishing boat clears for the "Deep Sea" but calls at a foreign port during such voyage, the master must submit a written report stating the reasons which made the call necessary, supported by the relevant entries in his log book.
