Oil Pipelines Act 1965

APPLICATION FOR OIL PIPELINE LICENCE

10-INCH O.D. PIPELINE

Notice is hereby given in accordance with section 8 of the Oil Pipeline Act 1965 that Mobil Producing Nigeria, whose registered office is at the New Niger House, 1-5 Odunlami Street, Lagos, has applied to the Federal Ministry of Mines and Power for the right to enter upon, take possession of and use for a period of twenty (20) years a strip of land on the Continental Shelf and underneath the waters thereof for the purpose of laying a 10-inch O.D. welded steel salt water pipeline from our Qua Iboe Terminal.

DESCRIPTION

1. The survey description of the pipeline is as follows :—

All that strip of land approximately 200 feet wide on the ocean bottom and onshore starting at a point on our Qua Iboe Terminal site whose Nigerian Co-ordinates are N60,298 meters; E616,452 meters and whose Greenwich Co-ordinates are N04° 32' 43"; E08° 0' 45" and extending on an approximate bearing of due South for a distance of approximately 0.39 miles to a point offshore whose Nigerian Co-ordinates are N59,670 meters; E616,452 meters and whose Greenwich Co-ordinates are N04° 32' 23"; E08° 0' 45".

2. A copy of the plan of the pipeline route identifying the sea bed affected may be inspected at the Ministry of Agriculture and Natural Resources, Calabar, the Federal Ministry of Mines and Power, Lagos and Port Harcourt and the office at New Niger House, 1-5 Odunlami Street, Lagos of the aforesaid Company.

3. Any person who considers that his interest or interests will be injuriously affected by the grant of the Licence should lodge orally or in writing, not less than seven (7) days before the hearing date in paragraph 6, with the Ministry of Agriculture and Natural Resources, Calabar, notice of objection stating the interest of the objector and the grounds of objection.

4. Any Public Officer who received a verbal objection in the course of his duties shall record the name and address, interest and grounds of objection of any person lodging such a verbal objection and shall forward the details to the Ministry of Agriculture and Natural Resources, Calabar.

5. Matters relating to the amount of compensation payable by the aforesaid Company for the use of sea bed and land affected shall not be material grounds to include in a notice of objection.

6. The Delegate of the Ministry of Agriculture and Natural Resources, Calabar, shall inquire into objections (if any) duly lodged in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 above at the office at Calabar at 9 a.m. on the 16th day of July, 1971 giving all parties an opportunity to be heard, and reports thereof shall be sent without delay to the Director of Petroleum Resources, Federal Ministry of Mines and Power, Lagos.

7. Compensation (if any) payable by the aforesaid Company for the use of the sea bed and land affected shall be determined by negotiations between the Company and those whose interest or interests are affected.

AMENDMENT No. 2

Customs and Excise Notice No. 5 published as Government Notice No. 1149 of 1969 in the Federation of Nigeria *Official Gazette* No. 41 of 31st July, 1969 is hereby amended.

By deleting paragraph 27 and substituting new paragraph 27 as hereunder :

27. FISHING BOATS—

(b) The master or his agent must make a report of the arrival and sailing of such boat and must at the earliest opportunity produce documentary evidence of registration under the Merchant Shipping Act 1962, No. 30.

(c) All fishing boats must be boarded by officer of Customs and Excise.

(d) All owners/agents of fishing boats operating in Nigeria, whether or not the fishing boats are Nigerian-owned, registered in Nigeria, or on charter, are required to register with the Board and furnish a list of their vessels.

(e) A standard log book as prescribed by the Ministry of Transport is to be kept by every master of a fishing boat. The log book must indicate clearly the extent of the voyage (including ports of call if any), period spent outside ports and the average gross weight of the catches.

(f) Where a fishing boat clears for the "Deep Sea" but calls at a foreign port during such voyage, the master must submit a written report stating the reasons which made the call necessary, supported by the relevant entries in his log book.
