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

MAJOR-GENERAL Y. GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces

WHEREAS by section 48 (2) of the Constitution of the former Western Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of Western State shall be the Chief Justice of State and such number of other Judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law : AND WHEREAS by section 49 (3) of the Constitution of the former Western Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 and as amended by the Constitution of the Western State (Amendment) Decree 1970 it is provided that if the office of Chief Justice of the State is vacant or if the person holding the office is unable to perform the functions of his office, then, until a person has been appointed to and has assumed the functions of that office or until the persons holding the office has assumed those functions, as the case may be, those functions shall be performed by such one of the Justices of the Court of Appeal of the State or of the other Judges of the High Court of the State as may from time to time be designated in that behalf by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee :

Now THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint MOSES OLATUNJI OYEMADE to act as Chief Justice of the High Court of Western State with effect from 1st September 1971.

WHEREAS by section 50 (2) of the Constitution of the former Eastern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the High Court of the South-Eastern State shall consist of the Chief Justice and such number of other Judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law :

AND WHEREAS by section 51 (1) of the Constitution of the former Eastern Nigeria modified as aforesaid it is provided that the Chief Justice and the Judges of the High Court shall be appointed by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee :

Now THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint EDEM KOOFFREH a Judge of the High Court of South-Eastern State with effect from 1st June 1971.
