OFFICIAL NIGERIAN PARTICIPATION IN THE FIRST ALL AFRICA TRADE FAIR TO BE HELD IN NAIROBI, KENYA, FROM 23RD FFBRUARY TO 5TH MARCH 1972

The Federal Military Government has approved official Nigerian participation in the First All Africa Trade Fair to be held in Nairobi, Kenya, from 23rd February to 5th March, 1972.

- 2. The purpose of this public announcement is to invite all classes of Nigerian producers, manufacturers, artists and merchants to prepare themselves in the task of supplying national exhibits that will conceivably be regarded as representative of all sections of the Federation of Nigeria.
- 3. Nigeria has long been elected a member of the Planning Committee which the Council of Ministers of the Organisation of African Unity (OAU) had set up to undertake the running of the projected First All Africa Trade Fair. This is one good reason why Nigeria should not only firmly support the Fair but also take an active part in it.
- 4. The OAU, in sponsoring the First All Africa Trade Fair, in conjunction with the Government of Kenya, hopes to demonstrate in practical terms its declared policy of promoting intra-African trade. The Fair which is expected to be patronised by all African Member States of the OAU will serve as a forum for mutual exchange of goods amongst African countries. It is hoped that the First All Africa Trade Fair will become a regular vehicle designed for promoting intra-African trade and, as such, it will rotate amongst countries of the Organisation of African Unity.
- 5. Apart from the main Fair itself, a 'Regional Trade for Development' Symposium will run concurrently with the sessions of the Fair. The Symposium is intended to provide prominent African economists and businessmen with a forum at which they could examine the opportunities and advantages of establishing permanent trade links throughout the African Continent. In this connection, policies concerning foreign capital investments and the development of industries on the African Continent will also be discussed.
- 6. On the Nigerian side as perhaps in the case of African countries of comparable status, the principal features of Nigeria's displays shall focus attention on the high level of industrial production in the country. Joint efforts between the Federal Ministry of Trade and all the State Ministries of Trade and Industry will be made to ensure that samples of goods produced or manufactured in Nigeria are exhibited at the First All Africa Trade Fair. In addition, samples of products of our Agriculture, Forestry, Fishery, Mining, Arts and Craft

industries will also be mounted on display. It will also be profitable for the sales representatives of Nigerian manufacturers and exporting firms to attend the Fair in order to seek good outlets for their products.

7. Lastly, it must be stressed that in an inter-African Exposition of the magnitude envisaged by the OAU Council of Ministers and at which competing African countries have to put up their best national displays, it is essential that co-operation in the supply of excellent product samples from all the producing sections throughout the Federation should, by all means, be secured. It is to be expected that national exhibits supplied should reflect the correct diversification in product lines which, although possessing export potentials but would illustrate the high level of productive capacity noticeable in all sectors of our national economy in recent years.

8. In order, therefore, to achieve this desirable objective for Nigeria at the First All Africa Trade Fair which, undoubtedly will serve as a shop window for each of the participating African countries, Nigerian producers, manufacturers, craftsmen, and export merchants are hereby invited to contact the Export Promotion and Trade Fair Division of the Federal Ministry of Trade, Lagos, or through their State Ministries of Trade and Industry, as the case may be, with a view to supplying national exhibits and obtaining further information on how to take part in the OAU Fair.

Customs and Excise Notice No. 57

Customs Tariff Act, 1965 AMBULANCES

Commencement: 1st October, 1971

Under Tariff Item No. 87.028 of Schedule I to the Customs Tariff Act 1965 No. 3, Ambulances are admissible to exemption from duty.

- 2. For the purpose of this Tariff Concession, the definition of an ambulance is any road motor vehicle built solely for the comfort and transportation of patients and which is essentially equipped as a mobile hospital with beds, one or two seats to accommodate a doctor and/or nurses, first-aid cabinets, provisions for easy sliding in of stretchers and sirens.
- 3. (a) Importers of ambulances shall only sell or dispose of such ambulances to an hospital, clinic, or voluntary organisation concerned with medical services. Sales otherwise than to the above-mentioned hospital, clinic or voluntary organisation shall be deemed to be a contravention of paragraph 1 of this notice and shall render such importer liable to prosecution under section 41 of CEMA No. 55 of 1958 unless duty on the said ambulance has been paid.
- (b) Any Hospital, clinic, voluntary organisations, or person who receives or purchases an ambulance subject to paragraph 1 above from any importer or any other person and uses such ambulance contrary to the purpose for which it was imported shall be liable to payment of duty involved or to prosecution under section 41 of the Customs and Excise Management Act No. 55 of 1958.
- 4. Traders and other persons who shall import ambulances duty free under the above tariff heading are requested to within 28 days of the disposal, notify the Comptroller, Board of Customs and Excise, Harvey Road, Yaba, of such disposal giving full particulars as to:—
 - (a) the number and date of the import entry of the ambulance, and
 - (b) the name of the hospital, clinic, voluntary organisation or person to whom such ambulance was sold or donated.
- Any importer who fails to comply with paragraph 4 of this notice shall be liable to prosecution under Section 65 of the Customs and Excise Management Act No. 55 of 1958.
