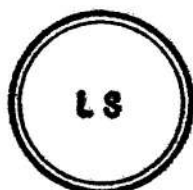

The Public is hereby warned that neither "Global Employment Bureau" nor its agents are known to or approved by the Federal Ministry of Labour which has not received any application from the Bureau to recruit adult Nigerians for work outside Nigeria in accordance with section 64 (i) of the Labour Code Act Cap. 91 of the Laws of the Federation of Nigeria. The law provides that "no person or association shall recruit any native (meaning Nigerian) for employment as a worker either within or without Nigeria unless such person or association be in possession of a licence" granted by the Nigerian Government. It should also be noted that under section 108 (i) of the Act, it is an offence to induce the recruitment of Nigerians by fraud or falsehood, intimidation, coercion or misrepresentation. The proposed recruitment of Nigerians for work in the various countries would therefore be illegal.
