**Languages.**—A good knowledge of Spanish with a working knowledge of English is required.

## ANNEX TO PAR/WMO.SF/1

### EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE NATIONAL METEOROLOGICAL SERVICE IN PARAGUAY

The purpose of the project is to assist the Government in the improvement and expansion of its meteorological observing network, the establishment of an adequate central service to process and disseminate meteorological information thus obtained, and in the modernization and improvement of the meteorological facilities at the Main Meteorological Office and the National Meteorological Centre at Asunción.

The project activities during its duration of three years will cover a programme for the expansion of the meteorological services, under which the following will be accomplished.

(a) Improve and expand the meteorological observing network by re-equipping 17 existing synoptic stations, establish 5 new synoptic, 18 agrometeorological and 18 hydrometeorological stations.

(b) Establish a calibration laboratory and workshop for meteorological instruments.

(c) Establish facilities and install data processing equipment for improved processing and publication of data and train counterpart personnel in the new procedures.

(d) Improve the facilities at the Main Meteorological Office at Asunción Airport through the installation of one facsimile receiver and one ceilometer.

The international team of experts for the project will consist of a Project Manager, an agrometeorologist and a hydrometeorologist. Six fellowships and equipment for about US \$220,000 will also be provided by UNDP. The Government will provide all necessary counterpart staff and facilities.
