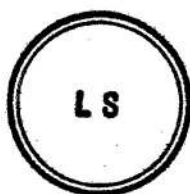

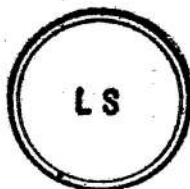

PRESS RELEASE

It has come to the notice of the Cabinet Office that certain persons who claim to have contacts in the Federal Public Service and other public sectors act as intermediaries between commercial and industrial establishments who transact businesses with Federal Ministries and Extra-Ministerial Departments. These intermediaries often claim large sums of money from their retainers allegedly for the purpose of influencing official decisions. In order to re-establish normal relations between the public sector and the private sector, henceforth, the channels of official communication will be as laid down hereunder:—

(a) Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Extra-Ministerial Departments, or their Deputies, will deal personally with Managing Directors, General Managers or the accredited top Management of substantial firms. The Chairmen of Boards of Directors or Directors wishing to participate in official discussion at this level must have reasonable shares in such Companies;

(b) No interviews will be granted to intermediaries claiming to be agents of any Company, except that they accompany their principals who, in the circumstances, must present the Company's case;

(c) Other Chief Executives of commercial firms or organisations shall have access to Heads of Division or Section in any Ministry or Department.

No other official contact is allowed at a lower level and all unauthorised visitors who have no valid pass will be turned out at the main gates. The implication of this is that private visits to the Ministries and Government Departments during working hours are prohibited;

(d) Where, for one reason or the other correspondence between a Company and the public sector is delayed, the accredited representative of the firm or Company concerned should raise the Company's case with appropriate public officers;

(e) The private sector is reminded that a dissatisfied party can exercise a right of appeal to the Commissioner of the Ministry concerned and, ultimately, to the Head of State where the matter under consideration falls within the jurisdiction of the Federal Government. All cases stemming from State Governments shall first be cleared with the State concerned.

2. It is the responsibility, as well as the right, of every citizen to demand and receive service and where such services are demanded under threat of reward, such cases, with full evidence must be laid to the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry and Head of Extra-Ministerial Department concerned for appropriate action.

3. All concerned are enjoined to adhere strictly to the procedures outlined in the preceding paragraphs in order to avoid possible embarrassment.
