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#### THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERATION

As modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966



By His Excellency General YAKUBU Gowon, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

GENERAL Y. GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces

Whereas by section 111 (2) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 it is provided that the Judges of the Supreme Court shall be the Chief Justice of Nigeria and such number of Justices of the Supreme Court (not being less than five) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 112 (1) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the Constitution (Amendment) Decree 1972 it is provided that the Chief Justice of Nigeria shall be appointed by the Head of the Federal Military Government:

Now THEREFORE, I, General YAKUBU GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commanderin-Chief of the Armed Forces, Federal Republic of Nigeria, do hereby appoint Dr Taslim Olawale Elias the Chief Justice of Nigeria with effect from 19th February 1972.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of the Federal Republic of Nigeria at Lagos, this 21st day of February, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two.
