Project—Reconstruction of Ibadan-Ife Road along Trunk Road A122

The Federal Government will shortly commence work on the above project. It is expected that the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development will finance the foreign exchange cost of the project. Contractors registered in Category 'D' (Civil Engineering) with the Federal Works Registration Board are invited to submit Prequalifications to tender. The extent of the project is briefly described below:—
