Whereas a trade dispute has arisen and now exists between the Joint Action Committee of the Staff of the Nigerian External Telecommunications Limited and the Nigerian External Telecommunications Limited;

AND WHEREAS the endeavours to promote a settlement by negotiation have proved unsuccessful;

Now therefore, The Commissioner for Labour, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4 (2) of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) Decree 1969, hereby refers the matters in dispute to the Industrial Arbitration Tribunal with the following terms of reference:—

- (i) Fringe benefits (rent allowance; overseas telephone call facilities for staff; staff canteen facilities);
- (ii) Pension scheme;
- (iii) Revision of salary scales;
