Duties.—The Senior Registrar of Deeds will be responsible to the Principal Deeds Registrar and will be required to perform duties similar to those of Deeds Registrar but at higher degree of responsibility and supervision. He will largely be responsible for the co-ordination of work in the State Land Registry. He will be required to attend Housing Board Meetings and to give advise on titles to Lands.
