- 1. The Plaintiff brings this action as the person authorised by law to prosecute and defend claims on behalf of the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.
- The 1st defendant was a Senior Technical Instructor engaged on Contract Agreement in the Federal Ministry of Education and posted to Yaba Trade Centre.
- 3. The 1st defendant held this post and performed his official duties thereto until 17th June, 1967, when he was dismissed from Service under General Order 04201 and Clause 10 of the Contract Agreement for unauthorised absence.
- 4. Whilst the 1st defendant was in the employment of the Federal Government, his salary was on his own instruction, paid into the bank account which he maintained with the 2nd defendant at the University of Lagos Branch, Akoka.
- 5. In view of the 1st defendant's absence from work without lawful excuse the 1st defendant ceased from that date (17th June, 1967) to be entitled to any salary from the Federal Government.
- 6. By a mistake of fact on the part of the Accounts Section of the Federal Ministry of Education the salary and other emoluments of the 1st defendant was paid into his said account at the 2nd defendant's University of Lagos Branch, Akoka, long after he had been dismissed from the Service of the Federal Government of Nigeria.
- 7. As a result, a sum of £659-10s-8d (Six-hundred and fifty-nine pounds, ten shillings and eight pence) representing salary to which the 1st defendant was not entitled was wrongly paid into his account with the 2nd defendant between 17th June, 1967 and 31st October, 1967 inclusive; and in addition, a further sum of £186 (One hundred and eighty-six pounds) was paid to him as Abnormal Passage Route Grant, the total sum of overpayment being £845-10s-8d (Eight hundred and forty-five pounds ten shillings and eight pence).

COMMONWEALTH AGRICULTURAL BUREAUX VACANCY FOR SECRETARY TO THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

Applications are invited for the post of Secretary to the Executive Council of the Commonwealth Agricultural Bureaux, which is due to fall vacant in August 1973.

Salary.—The salary of the post is £6,607.00 per annum. A non-superannuable but taxable allowance of 41 per cent is at present payable in addition.

Superannuation.—If the candidate appointed is not already a member of the Federated Superannuation System for Universities, he will be required to become a member. Under this scheme an assurance policy of his own choosing is taken out at a premium equivalent to 15 per cent of salary, of which onethird is deducted from salary and the remaining twothirds paid by the Executive Council.

Duties.—The Commonwealth Agricultural Bureaux were established over 40 years ago to provide a scientific information service for agricultural research workers in Commonwealth countries. The service has become fully international in use and in coverage and is the largest and most comprehensive of its kind in the world. The organization comprises four Institutes and ten Bureaux, of which all except one—the Commonwealth Institutes of Biological Control—are in the UK though widely dispersed. The staff comprises 172 scientists and linguists, 30 technicians and 163 administrative and clerical grades. The headquarters are at Farnham House and consist of a small Secretariat, an Accounts Branch, a Central Sale Branch and Reprinting Unit, with a total staff of 35. There is also at Farnham House a Systems Group of 13 under a Systems Manager who is responsible for the mechanization of CAB's services by the introduction of computer techniques.

The budget for the current quinquennium averages approximately £11m. per annum. Nearly two-thirds of the revenue comes from direct grants from Member Governments and the balance mainly from the sale of publications.

The Executive Council, comprising one represen-tative from each of the 25 Member Governments and one representative of the remaining Dependent Territories, is solely responsible for CAB. The Secretary is responsible to the Council for administration and finance generally, and is the channel for all communications from Directors of Institutes and Bureaux and from the Systems Manager, who are responsible for the scientific and technical activities of their respective units. These responsibilities are to the collective Council and not to any one Government or to any Department of a Government. Routine administration is centralized as much as possible at headquarters in order to leave the scientific and technical staff free to concentrate on the major task of collecting and disseminating scientific information, and administration presents special problems owing to the high degree of CAB's decentralization. CAB's growing involvement in international activities in the field of information science has also added a new and complex dimension to these problems.

Qualifications.—Candidates should have extensive experience at a senior level in Government Departments, preferably in a Department concerned with science, agriculture or forestry; but applications from candidates with appropriate non-Government experience will be considered. Experience of intra-Commonwealth or international organizations is desirable: and a speaking knowledge of one or more of the principal European languages other than English would be an advantage.

Conditions.—These follow broadly the conditions for the Scientific Civil Service in the UK. Appointment is subject to a certificate of medical fitness for the post, and is terminable by three months' notice on either side. Leave is at the rate of 5 weeks per annum, and sick leave is granted according to the regulations in force. Travelling and subsistence expenses are refundable at the appropriate rates, and an entertainment allowance of £50.00 per annum is payable.
