(e) **Scale of salary.**—Scale NP 5 £444 per annum.

**Qualifications.**—Candidates must possess a General Certificate of Education with passes at Ordinary Level in at least four subjects which must include English Language and Mathematics or a West African School Certificate with Credits in at least four subjects including English Language and Mathematics. These are minimum requirements and candidates with Advanced Level passes in General Certificate of Education will be preferred.

**Training.**—Selected applicants will be attested into the Force as Cadet Sub-Inspectors on probation, and will be required to undergo in the first instance, basic and advanced training courses for twelve months at the Police College, Ikeja. The training course, which will include Citizenship and Leadership Training Course, is strenuous and exacting. Cadets in training are expected to demonstrate a very high standard of physical fitness and mental alertness. There are excellent facilities at the Police College for games, athletics and other forms of healthy recreation.

Candidates, who during the training courses, have made satisfactory progress and passed the prescribed examinations will be posted for duty as Sub-Inspectors (£528-693) and attached to Police formations at the discretion of the Inspector-General for further training in practical Police duties. If, within the probationary period, i.e. within three years from the date of enlistment, a Sub-Inspector in training is found unsuitable for his post in the Force, his appointment will be terminated under General Order 02303.

**Promotion.**—As Sub-Inspectors, they will be eligible for promotion within the Inspectorate ranks of the Force.

Opportunities also exist for promotion to the rank of Assistant Superintendent of Police, but such promotion will however, be on merit alone and will depend solely on a candidate showing that he is suitable for consideration for appointment as a Superior Police Officer.

**Accommodation and Special privileges.**—Cadet Inspectors are entitled to free quarters (or an allowance in lieu), free uniforms and leave privileges as enjoyed by the Inspectorate of the Force, which include 35 to 42 days leave per annum and free transport facilities to and from the normal place of residence.

**Method of application.**—Application forms on which instructions are printed may be obtained at all Provincial and State Police Headquarters. Completed application forms must be forwarded to the Commissioner of Police of the State in which the applicant resides. Closing date for application is 31st December, 1972.

Suitably qualified candidates will attend a preliminary interview on 15th January, 1973 before a State Board appointed by the Commissioner of Police of the State. Successful candidates at a State Board will be required to attend a final selection Board Interview at the Police Force Headquarters, Moloney Street, Lagos on a date(s) to be announced later.

#### VACANCIES FOR PRINCIPAL FEDERAL INSPECTORS OF EDUCATION

The Federal Military Government has established a Federal Inspectorate Service designed to assist in the Inspection of Schools at Primary, Secondary and Post-Secondary Levels throughout the Federation and thus generally to enhance the growth of the educational system in Nigeria. A nucleus of the Service has been approved and candidates are now invited for the following vacancies of Principal Inspectors of Education.

2. Inspectors will be appointed on a subject basis in the following areas, until further expansion:—

English, French, Nigerian Languages, i.e. those currently examined by West African Examinations Council for the West African School Certificate and General Certificate of Education examinations), Arabic, History, Geography, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Art, Music, Woodwork, Metalwork, Technical Drawing, Agricultural Science, Home Economics, School Organisation and Management, Commercial and Secretarial subjects, Physical Education.

3. **Salary.**—Group 7 (£2,532 per annum).

4. **Qualifications.**—(1) Candidates should possess a good honours degree in a relevant subject from a recognised University and a Post-graduate Certificate or Diploma in Education and have at least 8 years' successful educational experience of which not less

than 6 years shall have been spent in a Post-primary Institution. The possession of higher qualification in related fields and/or previous experience of School Inspection at a senior level will be an advantage.

(ii) In the case of certain subjects (e.g. Woodwork, Metalwork, etc.), candidates with appropriate technical and professional qualifications with considerable post-qualification industrial and/or teaching experience in a Technical College may be considered.

5. **Duties.**—Under the direction of the Chief Federal Inspector, Principal Inspectors will join in team inspections of Schools throughout the country and report to States Ministries of Education and to Headquarters. They will also carry out individual subject inspections in their relevant subjects and report on such visits, pursue such follow-up action and undertake such other duties connected with institutional inspections from time to time, as may be required. While maintaining regular contact with Inspectorate Headquarters in Lagos, they will collaborate with the States Ministries of Education in a professional advisory capacity, give guidance and assistance from time to time to States Inspectors of Education on relevant aspects of the States Institutions and also be expected to provide professional advice on text-books, equipment, buildings, curriculum matters, etc. and on common professional standards as the need arises.

6. **Conditions of Service.**—The posts are pensionable and new entrants to the Public Service will normally be on probationary appointment for three years. Expatriates will only be appointed on contract for two tours of nine to ten months in the first instance. 10 per cent Contract Addition is payable.

A Government quarter is provided and rent is payable at the rate of 8½ per cent of basic salary subject to a maximum of £150 per annum. All applicants should note that they will be Federal Officers and as such, be ready to serve in any part of the Federation.

7. **Method of application.**—(a) *In Nigeria*—Applications from candidates not in Government Service should be completed in duplicate on the prescribed form which may be obtained from the Secretary, Federal Public Service Commission, Private Mail Bag No. 12586, Lagos.
