#### FEDERAL MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIES NIGERIAN STANDARDS ORGANISATION

#### CHANGE-OVER TO THE METRIC SYSTEM

The Federal Military Government has approved the following programme for the change-over to the Metric System in all sectors of the economy:—

#### STAGE I-ARITHMETICAL CONVERSION STAGE

#### 1. 1st January, 1973 .

All equipment and products calibrated or marked in imperial units must also carry the metric conversions or markings. The imperial units shall cease to be legal on 1st January, 1974.

All charges by public and private organisations (such as Customs tariff, unit prices, wharfage and harbour dues, sales taxes, postal rates, freight charges for rail, road, water, etc.) shall either be based exclusively on metric units or on a dual system (imperial and metric). The imperial bases shall be discontinued on 1st January, 1974.

Revision of Weights and Measures Act.

Educational Institutions will commence immediately to emphasise the shift to the metric system and all examinations will be metric by September 1975.

## STAGE II—CHANGE-OVER TO INTERNATIONALLY APPROVED METRIC SIZES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF PRODUCTS AND EQUIPMENT (1973-76)

## 2. Manufacturing and Crafts

Complete conversion to the use of SI throughout the manufacturing industry to make products based on convenient and accepted metric sizes and specifications—December 1976.

Transport.—Complete metrication of existing equipment—December 1976.

Posts and Telecommunications. - Complete metrication -1st January, 1974.

Works and Housing.—Change in survey division and overprinting of existing mile posts in metric units—1st January, 1974.

Power and Fuel.-Complete metrication-December 1974.

Agriculture and Allied Fields.—Complete metrication—December 1977.

Educational Institutions.—Conversion of books and materials to be completed—December 1974.

#### Consumer Goods:-

- (a) Compulsory labelling or marking in metric or dual-1st January, 1973.
- (b) Labelling or marking in metric only 1st January, 1974.

Building and Construction.—Complete change-over—1st January, 1975.

These decisions were based on the report of the national metrication committee which has now established a publicity committee to supervise the day-to-day public enlightenment on metrication. In this regard the following publicity items have been prepared and will soon be circulated:—

- (i) brochure on guide to the use of SI units;
- (ii) posters on the change-over to the metric system and everyday metric conversions (copies attached);
- (iii) a film on the change-over to the metric system in English, pidgin and three Nigerian languages.

The Nigerian Standards Organisation weekly training workshop on quality control and standardisation also includes discussions with factory personnels on the implications of the change-over to the metric system. Factory inspections have revealed that industries in Nigeria are already taking rapid steps to change-over to the metric system.
