#### "STRENGTHENING OF THE NATIONAL METEOROLOGICAL SERVICE"

The purpose of the project is to assist the government in expanding its meteorological and seismological observation network, modernizing obsolete equipment, improving data processing and applied research and providing advanced training for national technical personnel.
