1. Notice is hereby given in accordance with section 8 of the Oil Pipeline Act 1965 Cap. 145, that Nigerian Agip Oil Company Limited, whose registered office is at 11 Awolowo Road, Lagos, has applied to the Federal Ministry of Mines and Power for the grant of a licence to enter upon, take possession of and use for a period of 20 years a strip of land for the purpose of laying a 10½" O.D. ## DESCRIPTION

The route of the proposed pipeline is described as follows:

Starting at a 10" flange connection at the Oshi Flow Station which is at survey point P.I. 0; thence on an azimuth 91° 30' a distance of 232 metres to a Point P.I. 1; thence on an azimuth of 73° 49' a distance of 1291 metres to a Point P.I. 2; thence on an azimuth of 78° 34' a distance of 3,395 metres to a Point P.I. 3; thence on an azimuth of 09° 08' a



distance of 330 metres to a Point P.I. 4; thence on an azimuth of  $76^{\circ} 10'$  a distance of 1,012 metres to a Point P.I. 5; thence on an azimuth of  $118^{\circ} 27'$  a distance of 548 metres to a Point P.I. 6; thence on an azimuth of  $78^{\circ} 57'$  a distance of 1,151 metres to a Point P.I. 7; which is the tie in point on the Ogoda—Brass Pipeline.
