 - (c) Industrial Officer (Engineering), Scale A— №2,184-№3,528, (point of entry will depend on qualification and experience).
- (a) Principal Industrial Officer (Industrial Engineering):

Title of post.—Senior Lecturer in Meteorology.

Duties.—The expert will serve as a Senior Lecturer in the Department of Meteorology in the Faculty of Science, University of Nairobi, under the technical supervision of the Professor who is the Head of the University Component of the project (see Annex). His duties will be as follows:

EAST AFRICAN INSTITUTE FOR METEOROLOGICAL TRAINING AND RESEARCH RAF/71/199
