

IN THE MATTER OF INTERPRETATION OF COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT CONCLUDED BETWEEN THE RAILWAY WORKERS UNION OF NIGERIA AND THE NIGERIAN RAILWAY CORPORATION

WHEREAS a disagreement has arisen and now exists between the Railway Workers' Union of Nigeria and the Nigerian Railway Corporation as to the interpretation of a collective agreement reached between the Nigerian Railway Corporation, on the one hand and the Railway Workers' Union and the Railway Technical Staff Association on the other hand on 4th December, 1970:

Now therefore, I, Anthony Eromosele Enahoro, Federal Commissioner for Labour, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 4 (2) of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) (No. 2) Decree 1969, hereby refer the matter in dispute to the Industrial Arbitration Tribunal with the following terms of reference:

"To inquire into the disagreement in existence between the Railway Workers' Union and the Nigerian Railway Corporation in accordance with section 4 (1) (b) (i) of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) (No. 2) Decree 1969 over the interpretation of the following agreement:

"It was later agreed that promotion to Production Foreman (Loco) should be restricted to the Progress Office—the Assistant Production Foreman (Loco) to become Production Foreman (Loco); and Assistant Foreman (Inspection) to go back to the Parent Shop on seniority basis, provided this is in conformity with the practice adopted in the Carriage and Wagon Progress Office";

"The point in dispute is whether or not the above quoted agreement precludes one Mr. I. O. Alli, Assistant Foreman (Inspection), from promotion to the post of Production Foreman (Loco) for which he has been acting before the said agreement was concluded, and whose acting appointment was the subject of a protest by the Railway Workers' Union of Nigeria, which resulted in the said agreement".;

and to make such award, having regard to the circumstances of the dispute, and such other matters pertaining thereto or arising therefrom as the Industrial Arbitration Tribunal may deem necessary."
