#### MODIFICATION OF SCHEDULE "B" ELECTRICITY TARIFF

The National Electric Power Authority hereby gives notice that pursuant to the provisions of section 13 of the National Electric Power Authority Decree No. 24, a modified SCHEDULE "B" ELECTRICITY TARIFF (LOWER THAN THE PREVIOUS ONE), which has been approved by the Federal Executive Council became effective as from October 1973.

The new electricity tariff is as detailed hereunder.

#### SCHEDULE A

#### SINGLE-PHASE SERVICE TARIFF

Contract termination.—The Agreement shall be terminated on giving at least one month written notice either by the consumer or by the Authority.

#### NOTES ON SERVICE REGULATION

- 1. Voltage, Phase and Frequency of supply.—There are three tariff schedules applicable to all consumers served by N.E.P.A. namely.
- 1.1 Schedule A.—Applicable to all residential and some small commercial consumers. All consumers served under Schedule A are supplied at 230 volts, single-phase and 50 cycles/second.
- 1.2. Schedule B.—Applicable to small three phase commercial/industrial consumers. All consumers served under Schedule B are supplied at 400 volt three-phase, and 50 cycles/second.
  - 1.3. Schedule C .- Applicable to large commercial and industrial consumers.

All consumers under 500 KVA installed capacity are supplied at 400 volts, three-phase and 50 cycles/second.

Consumers with installed capacity of 500 KVA and above are supplied at 3,300; 6,600; 11,000; 33,000; 66,000; or 132,000 volts, three-phase and 50 cycles/second.

- 2. Connection fees.—Any new consumer served shall pay to the Authority a connection fee of N2 which shall be in addition to any service charge or capital contribution which the Authority might demand.
- 3. Payments in arrears.—The Consumer's attention is drawn to Section 26 of the National Electric Power Authority Decree No. 24 of 1972, which reads as follows:

"Whenever any consumer of electricity supplied by the Authority leaves the premises where such electricity has been supplied to him without paying the charges for electricity or meter rental due from him, the Authority shall be entitled to recover from the next tenant the arrears left unpaid by the former tenant unless the incoming tenant has, before consuming electricity, given notice to the Authority requiring the meter to be read, or has given notice of the date of commencement of his tenancy where no meter is supplied."

4. Discount.—There are discounts on electricity bills of consumers supplied at high voltages as shown in the following table:

- 5.—Special Meter Reading Charge.—Where a consumer requests the Authority to take a special meter reading outside the normal meter reading period, the consumer shall pay to the Authority a fee of fifty kobo (50k).
- 6. Re-Connection Fee after Disconnection for Non-Payment of Account.—Where an installation has been disconnected by reason of non-payment of account, the charge for re-connection will be as follows:
  - №1—where the outstanding amount is less than №3.
  - N2-where the outstanding amount is between N3 and N6.
  - N4—where the outstanding amount is above N6.
- 7. Disconnection and Re-connection for Consumer's Convenience.—There shall be no charge for disconnection and re-connection at consumer's request either for remodelling of his house, or for reinforcement and/or extension of his interior wiring, or for temporary non-occupancy. However, where such a re-connection involves shifting of the meter position, a re-connection fee of N2 will be payable by the consumer.
- 8. Disconnection of service.—The Authority reserves the right to discontinue its service for any of the following reasons:
  - 8.1 For non-payment of bill provided the bill remains unpaid 14 days after the date of dispatch of the bill as shown on the bill.
  - 8.2 For failure of the consumer to fulfil his contractual obligations for power supply service provided by the Authority.
  - 8.3 Without notice in the event of unauthorised use of electric service or tampering with Authority's equipment.
  - 8.4 For failure of the consumer to provide and install corrective equipment reasonably necessary in the opinion of the Authority to eliminate interference where the consumer's use of electric service interferes with system voltage and/or stability and adversely affects other consumers.
- 9. Discontinuance of supply.—Not less than three clear days notice in writing shall be given to the Authority by the consumer before quitting the premises, and in default of such notice, the consumer shall be liable to the Authority for all accounts until such notice is received or until the Authority accepts an application for supply to the same installation from another consumer. The Authority reserves the right to discontinue supply of electricity when other consumers are being connected or when the Authority's mains or apparatus are being tested or repaired, or in case of failure of supply through accident, fire, flood, tempest, breakdown of machinery or any unavoidable cause.
- 10. Continuity of service.—The Authority shall as much as possible try to ensure that power supply is reliable and continuous but cannot guarantee 24-hour uninterrupted power supply service. The consumer is therefore advised to install suitable protective equipment if such occurrences might damage his apparatus connected to the Authority's supply.
- 11. Responsibility for Authority's Apparatus.—The consumer shall insure and keep insured against damage or destruction by fire and shall be solely responsible for the safe custody of the meter and other apparatus belonging to the Authority installed at his premises, and shall not damage, alter, or remove the same, or obliterate or remove any such marks, words or numbers thereon, or permit any such damage, alteration, removal or obliteration. Without prejudice to the other provisions of these Regulations the consumer shall make good any such damage or reimburse the Authority to the extent of any loss the Authority may sustain by reason of any breach of these Regulations. The consumer shall forthwith give notice to the Authority of any break-down, failure, loss, injury or damage of or to the meter, or any apparatus belonging to the Authority installed in his premises.
- 12. Access to Premises.—As a condition of taking power supply services, authorised employees of the Authority shall have access to the consumer's premises at all reasonable hours to install, inspect, read, repair or remove its meters and to install, operate and maintain the Authority's property and to inspect and determine the connected electrical load. In this respect, an authorised employee shall carry identification and shall display it upon request.
- 13. Non-Liability of the Authority.—The Authority will not be liable for any loss or damage occasioned to any person or property, whether belonging to the consumer or not, arising out of any defects in or accident to the wiring installation or by the use of the electricity supplied or any apparatus used in connection therewith whether or not such wiring installation or apparatus belongs to the Authority or through any fault arising on the Authority's system or for any cause beyond their control.

14. Revision of Terms, Tariff, etc.—The Authority may from time to time, on giving notice to the consumer in writing or by public notice amend or alter any of the above Regulations of Supply or their scale of charges and such amendments or alterations shall take effect as from the date specified in the said notice.

COUNCIL OF LEGAL EDUCATION INFORMATION CIRCULAR NO. 5

#### CONCESSIONAL ADMISSION TO THE NIGERIAN LAW SCHOOL

The Council of Legal Education has for sometime now been considering the problems of how to help Nigerians who have become stranded in Great Britain because they have been caught by the English Council of Legal Education Consolidated Regulation 23 (part of which bars any students from further participation in its examinations after four unsuccessful attempts), and are thereby precluded from completing their legal studies.

The Council has recently decided to provide some assistance to any deserving case subject to the following conditions:—

- (a) That the applicant for the concessional admission produces satisfactory proof that:
  - (i) he has fully utilised all the chances open to him for taking the English Bar Finals Examination, and
  - (ii) he has actually been barred from further participation in future attempts on the sole ground of failure to secure a pass;
- (b) That his performances at the Bar Final Examinations are such that, in the opinion of the Council, there is a reasonable chance of the applicant being able to cope effectively with the course being proposed for him in the Nigerian Law School;
- (c) That any concession granted will apply only to those who—
  - (i) were enrolled at the Inns of Court in the United Kingdom BEFORE 12th October, 1964, and
  - (ii) take advantage of the Council's present offer between October 1973 and September 1976;
- (d) That any student admitted to the School under the terms stated in the foregoing paragraphs shall undergo a two-year course, during the first year of which he must pass the Part I Examination, and during the second year he must pass the Final Examination;
- (e) That no student will be permitted to proceed to the Final Examination if he has not passed the Part I Examination;
- (f) That a student who fails to pass the Part I Examination by the end of the first year will be asked to withdraw from the course;
- (g) That the student undertakes to satisfy such other stipulations as may be prescribed by the Council from time to time.
