Oil Pipelines Act 1965 (Cap 145)**APPLICATION FOR AN OIL PIPELINE LICENCE
16-INCH O.D. PIPELINE**

Notice is hereby given in accordance with section 8 of the Oil Pipeline Act 1965 (Cap 145) that the Gulf Oil Company (Nigeria) Limited whose registered office is at 19 Tinubu Square, Lagos has applied to the Federal Ministry of Mines and Power for the grant of a licence to enter upon, take possession of and to use for a period of 20 (Twenty) years a strip of land described hereafter for the purpose of laying a 16-inch outside diameter welded steel pipeline from the proposed Makaraba Flowstation, located 12311 metres north and 17116 metres east of the existing Abiteye Flowstation, for an approximate distance of 22.4 kilometres (13.94 miles) to a point within the existing Abiteye Flowstation. The entire route which falls within OML-49 in the Mid-Western State of Nigeria is demarcated on the ground by a survey trace marked with yellow stakes and is herein described:—

DESCRIPTION

1. All that strip of land approximately 22.4 kilometres long and situated within the Warri Division, Delta Province of the Mid-Western State of Nigeria, the route of which traverses tidal swamp and is shown in the Lessee's drawings No. 230-180 dated November, 1973.

The width of the said strip of land will be variable and will be approximately as follows:—

(a) When the route traverses forest—50 feet (15m).

(b) When the route traverses swamp, minor and major creeks—200 ft. (60m).

Where in the following text the grid azimuth of the line is described as proceeding to a certain P.I., the line will follow a simple curve from a tangent point before the P.I. and enter the next grid azimuth at a tangent point after the P.I. The exact distance from tangent point to tangent point will vary according to the radius of the curve used.

The route of the line is described as follows:

Starting at a point P.I. 0 at the proposed Makaraba Flowstation, the line runs on a grid azimuth of 247° 54' for a distance of 4708 metres to a point marked P.I. 1 thence on a grid azimuth of 299° 22' for a distance of 7785 metres to a point marked P.I. 2 thence on a grid azimuth of 198° 10' for a distance of 2532 metres to a point marked P.I. 3 thence on a grid azimuth of 270° 07' for a distance of 2855 metres to a point marked P.I. 4 thence on a grid azimuth of 213° 16' for a distance of 886 metres to a point marked P.I. 5 thence on a grid azimuth of 242° 37' for a distance of 1796 metres to a point marked P.I. 6 thence on a grid azimuth of 216° 43' for a distance of 1875 metres to a terminating point marked P.I. 7 which is the tie-in point of the proposed pipeline to the Abiteye 26-inch pipeline.

All grid azimuths and distances are approximate. All grid co-ordinates are expressed in metres. The grid used in this description is based on the projection system as used in Nigeria.

2. A copy of the plan of the pipeline route identifying the land affected may be inspected during all normal working hours at the Ministry of Lands and Housing, Benin City, the Federal Ministry of Mines and Power, Lagos and Warri and the office at 19 Tinubu Square, Lagos and Escravos of the aforesaid Company.

3. Any person who considers that his land or interests will be injuriously affected by the grant of the Licence should lodge orally or in writing, not less than seven days before the hearing date in Paragraph 6, with the Ministry of Lands and Housing, Benin City, notice of objection stating the interest of the objector and the grounds of objection.

4. Any Public Officer who receives a verbal objection in the course of his duties shall record the name and address, interest and grounds of objection of any person lodging such verbal objection, and shall forward such details to the Ministry of Lands and Housing, Benin City.

5. Matters relating to the amount of compensation payable by the aforesaid Company for the use of the land affected shall not be material grounds to include in a notice of objection.

6. The delegate of the Ministry of Lands and Housing, Benin City shall inquire into objections (if any) duly lodged in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 above at the office at Benin City at 10.00 a.m. on the 14th day of February, 1974, giving all parties an opportunity to be heard, and reports thereof shall be sent without delay to the Director of Petroleum Resources, Federal Ministry of Mines and Power, Lagos.

7. Compensation (if any) payable by the aforesaid Company for the use of the land affected shall be determined by negotiation between the Company and the landowners and/or occupiers.
