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THE FEDERAL REVENUE COURT DECREE 1973 (1973 No. 13)



By His Excellency General Yakubu Gowon, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces, Federal Republic of Nigeria.

GENERAL Y. GOWON,

Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces

WHEREAS by section 1 (2) of Federal Revenue Court Decree 1973 it is provided that the Federal Revenue Court shall consist of the President and such number of Judges (not being less than 4) as the Head of the Federal Military Government may by order prescribe:

AND WHEREAS by section 2 (4) of the aforesaid Decree it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the Federal Revenue Court other than the President's is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as President or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law to act in the office of a Judge of the Federal Revenue Court; and any person appointed shall continue to act for the period of the appointment or if no period is specified until his appointment is revoked by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee:

Now, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint Sogunle Akintoye Sowemimo to act as Judge of the Federal Revenue Court with effect from 1st February, 1974.
