ITEMS OF IMPORT ON SPECIFIC
IMPORT LICENCE

The attention of the public in general and all importers in particular is drawn to Legal Notice No. 20 of 1974—Import Prohibition Order 1974—published in the *Official Gazette Extraordinary* No. 15 of 1st April, 1974 which places the undermentioned items of import on specific import licence:

- (i) Unmanufactured tobacco, tobacco refuse;
- (ii) Other manufactured tobacco;
- (iii) Packaging containers excluding those made of glass;
- (iv) Duplicating paper;
- (v) Kraft paper (glazed or unglazed);
- (vi) Paperboard including liner and corrugated board;
- (vii) Bicycle tyres and tubes;
- (viii) Stockfish.

2. In order to obtain a licence, importers should obtain from this Ministry or from our Trade offices in the States application forms which should be duly completed and submitted with the following attachments:

- (a) Evidence of utilization of previous import licences and/or previous importation of the item of import;
- (b) Evidence of Business Name or Company registration where not previously submitted;
- (c) In case of Industrial applications, evidence of non-availability locally of raw materials required.

In addition to the above documentary evidences, applicants are enjoined to request their bankers to send directly to this office a report on their credit worthiness and main line of business.

3. Applicants are reminded to indicate the amount they require for each specific item for which they are applying. The business or registered address of the applicant should be stated. Post Office Box and Private Mail Bag numbers alone will not be accepted.

4. Applicants resident in the State are strictly enjoined to obtain their application forms from the Federal Trade Offices in the States and to submit the completed forms to the said offices. This is in the interest of the applicants and must be strictly complied with, as no direct application from any firm outside Lagos will be entertained at the Headquarters in Lagos.

5. The closing date for the submission of applications is 15th May, 1974. However, applications for industrial raw materials will continue to be entertained as the need arises.

6. Importers are reminded that it is obligatory to obtain an import licence in respect of restricted items of import before placing orders abroad. Any restricted import shipped in contravention of the licensing regulations will be strictly subjected to the prescribed penalties.
