WHEREAS by section 48 (2) of the Constitution of Mid-Western State as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of Mid-Western State shall be the Chief Justice of the State and such number of other Judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 49 (1) of the Constitution of the Mid-Western State modified as aforesaid it is provided that the Chief Justice and other Judges of the High Court of Mid-Western State shall be appointed by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee:





Whereas by section 50 (2) of the Constitution of the former Eastern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the High Court of the South-Eastern State shall consist of the Chief Justice and such number of other Judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 51 (4) of the Constitution of the former Eastern Nigeria modified as aforesaid it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the High Court other than the Chief Justice is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Chief Justice or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law to act in the office of a Judge of the High Court:

Now, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint Effiong Joseph NTIA to act as a Judge of the High Court of South-Eastern State with effect from the 1st April, 1974.

AND WHEREAS by section 49 (4) of the Constitution of the former Western Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the High Court of the State other than the Chief Justice is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Chief Justice or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law to act in the office of a Judge of the High Court and any person so appointed shall continue to act for the period of his appointment or if no period is specified until his appointment is revoked by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee:



Whereas by section 4 (1) of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the States (Creation and Transitional Provision) Decree 1966 and as amended in respect of Kano State section 3 of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law (Amendment) Edict 1970 of that State and in respect of North-Western State by section 3 of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law (Amendment) Edict 1970 of that State it is provided that the Sharia Court of Appeal shall consist of a Grand Kadi and not less than two other Judges learned in the Sharia:

AND WHEREAS by section 54 (3) of the Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the Sharia Court of Appeal other than the Grand Kadi is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Grand Kadi or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person with such qualification as may be prescribed by law for a person to hold the office of a Judge of the Sharia Court of Appeal; to act in the office of a Judge of the Sharia Court of Appeal:

Now, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint Mika'ilu Marafa to act as Judge of Sharia Court of Appeal of Kano State and of North-Western State with effect from 1st June, 1974 to 30th November, 1974.
