RETURN OF INCOME

Pursuant to section 44 (1) of the Companies Income Tax Act 1961 as amended by section 8 (1) of the Income Tax (Amendment) Decree 1966, NOTICE is hereby given to the following effect:

1. Every company liable to tax under section 44 (1) of the Companies Income Tax Act 1961 as amended by section 8 (1) of the Income Tax (Amendment) Decree 1966 shall, within the period of twenty-one days from the date of this NOTICE, prepare and deliver to the Federal Board of Inland Revenue a complete and accurate statement of income derived from all sources for the purposes of assessment to income tax for the year 1974-75.

2. The Return of Income in respect of such companies shall be forwarded to the following officers of the Federal Board of Inland Revenue:
