As modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967



By His Excellency General YAKUBU GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces, Federal Republic of Nigeria.

GENERAL Y, GOWON, Head of the Federal Military Government, Commander-in-chief of the Armed Forces

Whereas by section 4 (1) of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 and as amended in respect of Kwara State by section 3 of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law (Amendment) Edict 1970 of that State and in respect of North-Central State by section 3 of the Sharia Court of Appeal Law (Amendment) Edict 1970 of that State it is provided that the Sharia Court of Appeal shall consist of a Grand Kadi and not less than two other Judges learned in the Sharia:

AND WHEREAS by section 54 (3) of the Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966, and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967, it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the Sharia Court of Appeal other than the Grand Kadi is vacant or if the person holding the office is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person, with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law for a person to hold the office of a Judge of the Sharia Court of Appeal; to act in the office of a Judge of the Sharia Court of Appeal:

Now, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint MR JUSTICE ABUBAKAR BASHIR WALL to act as Deputy Grand Kadi of the Sharia Court of Appeal of Kano State and of North-Western State with effect from 1st May, 1974. He is required to revert to the High Court with effect from 1st of August, 1974.

Whereas by section 50 (2) of the Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966, the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 and the Constitution (Northern States) (Amendment) Decree 1969 it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of each-of the States created out of the former Northern Nigeria shall be the Chief Justice and such number of other Judges (not being less than two) as may be prescribed by law:

AND WHEREAS by section 51 (6) of the said Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria modified as aforesaid it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the High Court other than the Chief Justice is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Chief Justice or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law to act in the office of a Judge of the High Court:

Now, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint UMARU ATU KALGO to act as a Judge of the High Court of Kano State and of the High Court of North-Western State for a period of six months with effect from 1st May, 1974.





APPOINTMENT OF LICENSED BUYING AGENTS FOR THE 1974-75 COCOA SEASON

It is notified for general information that the Board is prepared to consider applications from bona fide cocoa farmers, i.e. Farmers' Unions, Co-operative

Marketing Unions, Farmers' Co-operatives, Group farmers and large scale individual farmers for appointment as Licensed Buying Agents for the 1974-75 Cocoa Season which will open about September 1974. The exact date will be notified later by publication in the Western Nigeria Gazette.

- Applicants will be required to produce evidence that they are likely to be able to fulfil the minimum conditions set out in the following paragraphs, which are based on—
 - (a) the normal functions which a licensed buying agent is required to perform;
 - (b) ability to handle a minimum of 400 tons for an average season;
 - (c) stipulated conditions as regards storage, evacuation, etc.
- 3. FUNCTIONS OF LICENSED BUYING AGENTS

The main functions which licensed buying agents will be required to perform on behalf of the Board are:—

- (a) to grade cocoa at gazetted buying stations;
- (b) to bag and arrange for inspection in accordance with the regulations;
- (c) to provide suitable storage until the time of evacuation to port;
- (d) to make returns of gradings and stocks as the Board or its duly authorised executive may require;
- (e) to arrange for conveyance and delivery of cocoa to Board's stores, Ikeja and Apapa and according to instructions which may be issued from time to time by the Board's Executive.
- 4. MINIMUM CONDITIONS
- (a) Applicants must produce evidence that they are bona fide cocoa farmers;
- (b) Applicants must furnish in duplicate under separate cover, the name/names of their members and the location of their farms in order to facilitate physical checking of the farms and their productive capacity.
- (c) Applicants must produce evidence of necessary organisation to ensure proper performance of the duties of a licenced buying agent.
- (d) Applicants must be able to produce and grade with reasonable regularity throughout a season a minimum of 400 tons of cocoa (i.e. Main and Light Crops inclusive).
- (e) Storage and Twine.—Applicants must be able to provide evidence that they have available in their proposed areas of operation proper storage for at least two hundred tons of cocoa. All stores must comply with the requirement of, and be approved by the Western Nigeria Produce Inspection Service. It is the responsibility of the applicant to request, in writing, the Produce Officer of the area concerned to inspect and approve his stores. Applicants will be required to produce evidence of ability to provide sufficient twine to cover at least the minimum production requirement.
- (f) General.—Applicants must be prepared to produce satisfactory evidence to show that they are fully conversant with the cocoa trade and likely to be able to fulfil the following conditions:—

- (i) Inspection of Cocoa—That they will be able to provide an adequate labour force at all stores to handle cocoa at the time of inspection;
- (ii) Returns—That they will render promptly and accurately all returns, particularly of gradings and stocks, which may be called for;
- . (iii) Evacuation: (a) That they will be able to make arrangement to secure the necessary transport to ensure the smooth and regular evacuation of cocoa by approved routes;
- (b) That they possess the necessary organisation at port or the ability to secure reliable agents to ensure the carrying out of all duties involved in the delivery of cocoa to Board's stores.
- 5. Method of application.—Application forms and details as to their completion can be obtained free of charge from the Headquarters of the Western Nigeria Marketing Board, Cocoa House, Bank Road Ibadan.
- 6.
