- materials for the above; (e) developing the practical content of course entrance tests where applicable, and trade skill

achievement tests for interim and final assessment

- of trainees under instruction; (f) laying out of electrical workshops, laboratories, demonstration and classrooms, and installation of the necessary machinery and equipment:
- (g) guiding, assisting and training counterparts who will continue the work after the departure of the expert and assist with the over-all training of trade instructors and technical teachers;
- (h) perform any other duties in connection with his assignment which are within his particular competency as a vocational training expert.

Qualifications required.—Good general and technical education up to technician level in electrical trade. A degree in the electrical engineering field desirable.

At least five years' experience as a craftsman in electrical trades including electrical installation. Experience as technical teacher/vocational training

instructor at a technical/vocational training institution or within the industry. Ability and experience in preparing programmes

and developing of training materials for practical and related theoretical instruction.
