RIGHT OF ACCESS TO INSPECTORS OF ENTERPRISES TO INVESTIGATE COMPANIES OR ENTERPRISES AFFECTED BY THE NIGERIAN ENTERPRISES PROMOTION DECREE 1972

Information has reached the Nigerian Enterprises Promotion Board that some enterprises affected by the Nigerian Enterprises Promotion Decree 1972 are refusing Inspectors of Enterprises appointed under section 6 of the Decree access to their buildings, premises and books in order to determine whether their businesses are being carried on for the purposes authorised by the Decree on the pretext that the enterprises concerned have obtained letters of clearance from the Nigerian Enterprises Promotion Board. The Board wishes to stress that this is an offence under section 6 (4) (a)—(c).of the Decree which vests a duly appointed Inspector of Enterprises power of access at all times to any building, premises and books of accounts or any other relevant books of the company in order to determine whether or not the enterprise is operating in conformity with the provisions of the Decree. It needs hardly be emphasised that the work of the Inspectors of Enterprises under the Decree is a continuing one and not a-once-and-for-all exercise. The fact alone that an enterprise has been issued with a letter of clearance or even a certificate of compliance, exemption or extension of time as the case may be, does not exempt such an enterprise from being inspected from time to time by the Board's Inspectors of Enterprises in order to ensure that compliance with the Decree is sustained conti-nuously, especially as it is possible for a company or an enterprise to comply with the provisions of the Decree at a particular time only to proceed thereafter to act in contravention. The only means the Board can possibly detect such a deviation from the path of compliance is to rely on the reports of inspection undertaken from time to time by its team of Inspectors of Enterprises.

- 2. All concerned are therefore advised in their own interests to give maximum co-operation to the Board's Inspectors of Enterprises any time they are around to carry out their lawful assignment under the Decree. In order to avoid incidence of impersonation, all bona fide inspectors are issued with identity cards which are authenticated by the signature of the Chairman of the Nigerian Enterprises Promotion Board.
