WHEREAS by section 122 (2) of the Constitution of the Federation as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966 and the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of Lagos State shall be the Chief Justice of Lagos State and such number of other Judges (not being less than five) as may be prescribed by law :

AND WHEREAS by section 123 (1) of the Constitution of the Federation modified as aforesaid it is provided that the Chief Justice and other Judges of the High Court of Lagos State shall be appointed by the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee :

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint Mr Justice JOSEPH ADETUNJI ADEFARASIN as Chief Justice of the High Court of Lagos State with effect from 1st November, 1974.

WHEREAS by section 50 (2) of the Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966, the States (Creation and Transitional Provisions) Decree 1967 and the Constitution (Northern States) (Amendment) Decree 1969 it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of each of the States created out of the former Northern Nigeria shall be the Chief Justice and such number of other Judges (not being less than two) as may be prescribed by law :

AND WHEREAS by section 51 (6) of the said Constitution of the former Northern Nigeria modified as aforesaid it is provided that if the office of any Judge of the High Court other than the Chief Justice is vacant or if the person holding the office is acting as Chief Justice or is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his office, the Supreme Military Council, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, may appoint a person with such qualifications as may be prescribed by law to act in the office of a Judge of the High Court :

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SUPREME MILITARY COUNCIL, acting after consultation with the Advisory Judicial Committee, do hereby appoint UTHMAN MOHAMMED to act as a Judge of the High Court of North-Western State and of the High Court of Kano State with effect from 22nd October, 1974 until Mr Justice HASAN returns from leave.

CHAIRMAN'S STATEMENT—1973 ACCOUNTS

I am pleased to report that as in previous years the Corporation had a very satisfactory result. The overall net premium income went up from ₦2,570,552 in 1972 to ₦2,869,547 in 1973, and our net profits increased from ₦697,987 to ₦835,783.

As I indicated in my report last year the Branches in Enugu, Ibadan and Kano were opened during 1973. The effect of the new Branches will be fully felt during the current year. Efforts are being made to consolidate our positions at the various Branches to make it possible for us to extend our activities to the other States within the foreseeable future.

During the year under review the Corporation concluded the take-over of the Niger Insurance Company Limited from the Yorkshire General Life Assurance Company Limited. At the time of the take-over Niger's Life Fund stood at ₦11,000,000. The Corporation also acquired substantial equity participation in the Nigerian Acceptances Limited. The Corporation took advantage of the various equities offered by the Nigerian Enterprises Promotion Decree. In addition other measures were taken to further diversify the Corporation's investment portfolio.

Our General Reserve was increased by ₦300,000 to ₦1,500,000 to further strengthen the financial position of the Corporation.

The Management and staff have contributed immensely towards the success achieved by the Corporation. On behalf of the entire Board I wish to express my gratitude to them. I am also very appreciative of the support given to us by some of our Broker connections, the various Government Corporations and the Insuring public throughout the country.

With the increased activities being generated by the development programmes of the various Governments of the Federation and the Corporation's considerably enlarged image, I am confident that we shall achieve greater success in the forthcoming year.

The net premium written amounted to ₦102,746. The total Life Fund—including the Life Grant—as at 31st December, 1973 was ₦644,648.

1. *Share Capital.*—The Authorised and Issued Share Capital of the Corporation remained at the statutorily fixed amount of ₦2 million whilst the Federal Military Government of Nigeria remained the sole Shareholders of the Corporation.

2. *Loan.*—The rate of interest on the Loan of ₦200,000 granted under Decree No. 22 of 1969 towards meeting the initial Expenses/Start-off working capital was agreed at five per centum per annum.

However, the interest actually paid during the financial year under review was ₦19,900 out of the previous provisions which amounted to ₦25,000—thereby leaving an excess provision of ₦5,100 which has been written back to the Profit & Loss Appropriation Account.

3. *General Reserve.*—The amount transferred to General Reserve in respect of the financial year was ₦300,000 and this brought the total amount at 31st December, 1973 to ₦1,500,000.

4. *Leasehold Building.*—The purchase of the Buildings at No. 8A, Sokoto Road, Kaduna in the sum of ₦57,915 was completed in 1973 after appropriate valuation by Consultants retained by the Corporation. The purchase brought to two the number of Real Properties wholly-owned by the Corporation.

5. *Investments.*—During the financial year under review, the Investments of the Corporation were considerably diversified.

The total par values of the Investments inclusive of Treasury Bills, Quoted and other Unquoted Investments amounted to ₦3,606,392.

6. *Life Assurance.*—The Life Department's activities and Assets etc, for 1973 will be found under the appropriate separate headings in the Accounts.
