The 1975 competition for entry into the Administrative and the Special Departmental Classes in the East-Central State of Nigeria Public Service will be held on Friday, 27th June, 1975. The Special Departmental Classes comprise the Scale A posts of Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Produce Officer, Inspector of Taxes, Industrial Promotions Officer, Commercial Officer, Information Officer, and Loans Administrator.

**2. The competition will consist of :—**

- (a) a qualifying written examination conducted by the East-Central State Ministry of Education.
- (b) a series of tests and interviews conducted by the Public Service Selection Board; and
- (c) an interview by the Public Service Commission.

Only candidates who attain the qualifying standard in the written examination will be invited for the tests and interviews to be conducted by the Public Service Selection Board. The Public Service Commission will subsequently select, in the light of the performance of such candidates, those who will be interviewed by the Commission.

**3. Qualification.—(A) Officers not yet in East-Central State Service—**To be eligible to enter for the competition, a candidate, who is not already in the public service of the East-Central State of Nigeria, should either possess the following qualifications or be sitting for them in the course of the year, viz :—

**(i) Administrative Class :**

(a) First or Second-class Honours Degree, or a higher Degree, preferably in Arts, Economics or other Social Sciences from a recognized University; and

(b) Honours Degree (Pass or Third Class); First or Second-Class General Degree, from a recognized University, in addition to a Diploma in Public Administration from a recognized Institution.

**(ii) Inspector of Taxes :**

(a) Final Certificate of one of the following professional bodies :—

- (i) Chartered Accountants;
- (ii) Society of Incorporated Accountants and Auditors;
- (iii) Association of Certified and Corporate Accountants;
- (iv) Institute of Municipal Treasurers and Accountants;
- (v) Institute of Cost and Works Accountants.

(b) Honours Degree in Accountancy, or related subjects with Accountancy as a special subject, from a recognized University.

(c) A degree in Law from a recognized University.

(d) A call to the Bar.

**(iii) Produce Officer—**An Honours Degree in Agriculture, Commerce, or Economics from a recognized University.

**(v) Other "Scale A" Posts.—**For the posts of Industrial Promotions Officer, Commercial Officer, Loans Administrator, and Information Officer, a candidate should either possess the following qualifications, or be sitting for them in the course of the year :—

First or Second-class Honours Degree in Arts, Economics, Statistics, Sociology, Business Administration, Commerce, from a recognized University.

"Recognized" in the above context means "recognized by the Government of East-Central State of Nigeria."

**(B) Serving Officers.—**The following categories or serving officers are eligible to enter for the competitive examinations.

(i) Those in possession of any of the qualifications listed in paragraph 3 (A) above, but who have not previously passed the competitive examinations for entry into the relevant class and;

(ii) Those in the General Executive and Secretarial Class who are either graduates or holders of appropriate Diploma in Public Administration or Management and who have served for, at least, three years.

4. The purpose of the written examination is not to test the candidates in the subjects which they studied for their degrees, but to test their ability to think clearly, to understand and write English Language, and also to test their knowledge of current affairs, particularly West African Affairs. Notes for the guidance of candidates, drawn up by the Ministry of Education will be issued to all candidates by that Ministry in due course.

5. The written examination will consist of the following papers :—

(i) English (Precis and Critical Appreciation). This will consist of a fairly long and complex passage and candidates will be required to summarize it in their own words and to make critical comments on its central idea;

(ii) Current Affairs.—This will comprise two separate papers, one of which will be a paper of three compulsory questions of the traditional essay type and the other an objective test of fifty questions. The questions are designed to test the candidates' intelligent awareness of current affairs which any educated person may be presumed to possess;

(iii) General.—This will consist of two questions; the first, known as the "Logical Force Passage", will test the candidates' ability to detect dubious thinking and the second known as "Statistical Inference Question", will test their ability to draw correct inferences from a table of numerical data.

6. The written examination will be held from 9 a.m. on Friday, 27th June, 1975 at the following Centres :—

Lagos, Enugu, Kaduna, Accra, Freetown, London, Washington and at such other centres as may be determined later.

7. Candidates will be responsible for arranging and meeting the cost of their accommodation and transport.

8. Each candidate will be required to pay a fee of ₦10.50 which will not be refundable. No responsibility will be accepted for money sent in any manner other than the one prescribed in paragraph 9 below.

9. *Method of application.*—Candidates who have already applied for appointment to any of the classes mentioned in paragraph 1 above should, if in Nigeria, send to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, Enugu, crossed Postal or Money Order for the examination fee of ₦10.50 each. ## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*Programme for strengthening the Agrometeorological and Hydrological Services of the Sahelian countries and establishment of a Centre for training and for applied agrometeorology hydrology*

The strengthening of national services and the setting up of the Centre are among the medium-term measures intended to minimize the effects of climatological disasters and to improve the living conditions of the inhabitants of this area. The seven countries affected by the drought have set up a joint body in order to combine their efforts : the Permanent Inter-State Committee for the Fight against Drought in the Sahel (CILSS). These countries are : the Gambia, Upper Volta, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Senegal and Chad.

The present programme consists of :

Seven national projects intended to develop the agrometeorological and hydrological observational networks, to strengthen services for data processing and providing users with short-term forecasts, and lastly, the training of technical personnel required for these tasks ;

a regional Centre to provide training for these personnel. This Centre will subsequently have personnel and equipment for data processing on a regional basis.

Each national project comprises :

the services of an expert for two years, responsible for supervising meteorological and agrometeorological activities undertaken in the country ;



the supply of equipment for strengthening the networks ;

granting fellowships ;

hydrological activities undertaken under a subcontract with ORSTOM (except the Gambia). The Centre comprises :

the services of a Programme Manager responsible for the management and implementation of the entire programme ;

the services of four instructors in meteorology (2), agrometeorology (1) and climatology (1) ;

the services of two experts in operational hydrology responsible for planning and supervising the work of the subcontractor ;

the supply of didactic material.

It is also proposed to add data processing facilities on a regional scale by attaching two experts, providing data processing equipment and a telecommunication network for the collection and redistribution of these data.

The duration of these operations will be five years for the Centre and two years for the national projects.

The programme should commence in April 1975. The present post is part of the national project for Mali.

(ii) Staff member arriving unaccompanied—15 days at 100 Swiss Francs.

(iii) When the spouse and children arrive after the staff member, they receive the grant under paragraph (i) and the staff member himself receives for 15 days, from the time of their arrival, the sum of 100 Swiss Francs per diem in addition to the amount paid to him under paragraph (ii).
