WHEREAS by section 48 (2) of the Constitution of the Mid-Western State as modified by the Constitution (Suspension and Modification) Decree 1966, it is provided that the Judges of the High Court of Mid-Western State shall be the Chief Justice and such number of other Judges (not being less than six) as may be prescribed by law:

They will be senior line and staff managers who are already in positions of substantial responsibility in their organisations or younger managers whose abilities have already been recognised as qualifying them for accelerated advancement to positions of higher responsibility. Possession of a university degree or equivalent qualification will be welcome but not essential.

Ideally participants should be between the ages of 35 and 50 years as at 1st January, 1976.

3. *Content.*—In accordance with the College's established policy, the course will lay particular emphasis on profit planning, human resource management, organisational structures and systems, the management of material resources and on the quantitative (financial and statistical) elements in management. Participants will also be exposed to the use of modern management techniques in the public and private sectors of the Nigerian economy.

4. *Duration.*—Each course will last 5 weeks and will consist of two parts, separated by a recess of five to six weeks. The first part will last 3 weeks while the second will last 2 weeks. These courses, which will be fully residential, will be held in two first-class hotels in different parts of Nigeria.
