Oil Pipeline Act 1965 (Cap. 145)

APPLICATION FOR AN OIL PIPELINE LICENCE
10 INCH O.D. PIPELINE

Notice is hereby given in accordance with section 8 of the Oil Pipeline Act 1965 (Cap. 145) that Nigerian Agip Oil Company Limited, whose registered office is at 11 Awolowo Road, Lagos has applied to the Federal Ministry of Petroleum and Energy for the grant of a Licence to enter upon, take possession of and use for a period of twenty (20) years a strip of land for the purpose of laying a 10 inch O.D. Pipeline from a proposed flowstation located in the Kwale Field to the existing Akri Flowstation. This strip of land is situated in the Aboh Division of the Mid-Western State and in the Oguta Division of the East-Central State. The route is demarcated on the ground with pillars in concrete and herein described.

2. *Description.*—The strip of land approximately 17 km long is situated in the Aboh Division of the Mid-Western State and in the Oguta Division of the East-Central State. The route which traverses dry land and seasonal swamps is shown on the Licencee's Drawing No. 73/375 dated June 1975. The width of the strip of land to be occupied will be variable and will be approximately as follows:—

- (a) Where the route of the pipeline traverses Dry land and seasonal swamps 50ft (15.24m)
- (b) In the vicinity of all points of intersections (P.I.'s) 100ft (30.48m)
- (c) At all River Crossings 100ft (30.48m)

Where in the following text the bearing of the line is described as proceeding to a certain P.I., the line will follow a simple curve from a tangent point before the P.I. and will enter the next bearing at a tangent point after the P.I. The exact distance from tangent point

to tangent point will vary according to the radius of the curve used. The route of the proposed pipeline is described as follows:—

Starting at the proposed Kwale Flowstation near Kwale Well No. 1 which is at survey point P.I.-O, thence on an azimuth of $100^{\circ} 04'$ a distance of 1,765 metres to point P.I.-1, thence on an azimuth of $73^{\circ} 02'$ a distance of 969 metres to point P.I.-2, thence on an azimuth of $106^{\circ} 32'$ a distance of 2,650 metres to point P.I.-3, thence on an azimuth of $96^{\circ} 30'$ a distance of 4,511 metres to point P.I.-4, thence on an azimuth of $107^{\circ} 21'$ a distance of 2,795 metres to point P.I.-5, thence on an azimuth of $104^{\circ} 57'$ a distance of 2,145 metres to point P.I.-6, thence on an azimuth of $89^{\circ} 21'$ a distance of 2,508 metres to point P.I.-7, which is the point where the pipeline enters the Akri Flowstation to be tied-in to the existing Manifold of the Akri-Ebocha 14" Pipeline. All azimuths above refer to grid north.
