NOW THEREFORE, I, MAJOR-GENERAL HENRY EDMUND OLUFEMI ADEFOPE, FEDERAL COMMISSIONER FOR LABOUR, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 4 (2) of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) Decree 1969 hereby refer the matters in dispute to the Industrial Arbitration Tribunal with the following terms of reference :—

To inquire into the trade dispute declared by City Retreading Workers' Union against City Retreading Service in accordance with section 4 (1) of the Trade Disputes (Emergency Provisions) (Amendment) Decree 1969 over the following issues :—

- “(i) Management refusal to pay the workers the Udoji Award according to City Council employees, but paid them as Private Sector, whereas, the City Retreading Service is the property of the Lagos City Council,
- (ii) Management's refusal to submit the conditions of service of the department to the Union for further discussion and amendments if any,
- (iii) Management's introduction of divide and rule, thereby creating division amongst the workers, and regarding none members of the Union as its favourites,
- (iv) Refusal of the Management to transfer the Daily-Rated staff who have completed more than seven years to fixed establishment and thereby paying them less than 26 working days,
- (v) Termination of Messrs : Benson Adeyemi and Olafisote because they are Union members,
- (vi) Refusal of the Management to grant Mr Oduma his annual increment without any reason(s) and also despite the repeated letters of the Union to the Management to show cause why the man should be deprived of his annual increment which is a violation of our 1972 agreement and
- (vii) Demotion of Mr Festus from Clerk to Labourer for the past four years.”

and to make such awards, having regard to the circumstances of the dispute, and such other matters pertaining thereto or arising there from as the Industrial Arbitration Tribunal may deem necessary.

NOTICE OF DISALLOWANCE OF AN APPEAL AGAINST THE REGISTRAR'S INTENTION TO CANCEL THE REGISTRATION OF AN INSURER

The public is hereby notified that the Commissioner for Trade in exercise of powers conferred under the section 9 of Insurance Companies Act 1961 has on 31st December, 1975 disallowed the appeal of the registered Insurance Company listed below against the intention of the Registrar of Insurance to cancel its registration as an insurer.

2. The Certificate of registration as an insurer issued to the company and listed hereunder is therefore cancelled with effect from 31st December, 1975.

3. By section 9 (2) of Insurance Companies Act 1961, it shall be an offence for the company to carry on insurance business in the Federation after the expiry of 12 months from the date of cancellation ; that is after 1st January, 1977. The twelve months period is given by Law to enable the company to wind up any insurance business it may have in hand and fulfil its obligation under the existing contracts as at the date of cancellation of its certificate of registration.
