ANNOUNCEMENT OF VACANCY PAK/WMO/14* Rev. 1

Country.—Pakistan.

Title of post.—Expert in Installation and Operation of Hydrological Equipment.

Duration: One year.

When required.—October 1976.

Duty station.—Lahore (with frequent trips within the country).

Duties.—The expert will be a member of the team of WMO experts entrusted with the implementation of the project entitled: "Improvement of the River and Flood Forecasting and Warning System for the Indus River Basin" (a short description of the project is given in the Annex). Under the general supervision of the team leader and under the direct guidance of

the expert in hydrological network design and operation, the expert will be called upon to undertake the following duties:

- (i) to participate in the improvement of the hydrometric network in the project area;
- (ii) to participate in the installation and operation of automatic and telemetering gaugingstations to measure the water level and discharge of rivers, rainfall and sediment transport;
- (iii) to participate in the organization of a realtime and non-real-time hydrological data collection, transmission and processing system in order to prepare input data for the operation of flood routing and sediment transport model;
- (iv) to inspect periodically the hydrological stations and give training to local personnel in making hydrological observations and in the maintenance of instruments.

Qualifications.—The candidate should have a degree from a recognized university or equivalent institution in either geophysics or engineering (civil or agricultural) or in a related field. He should have extensive field experience in the installation, operation and maintenance of hydrological stations. A knowledge of telemetering equipment would be an advantage. A certain experience in training counterpart personnel is necessary.

Languages.—A good working knowledge of English is required.

Salary level.—Initial net salary equivalent of US \$17,532.00 per annum, plus allowances.

Allowances

- 1. Post adjustment.—This adjustment is variable according to cost of living at the duty station. At present, for Lahore, the equivalent of US \$510.00 per annum is payable for an expert without dependents and the equivalent of US \$765.00 per annum is payable for an expert with dependents.
- 2. Assignment allowance.—Without dependants, equivalent of US \$1,600.00 per annum; with dependants, equivalent of US \$2,000.00 per annum.
- 3. Dependency allowance.—Equivalent of US \$400.00 per annum for a dependent wife; equivalent of US \$450.00 per annum for each dependent child.
- 4. Education grant.—A grant up to a maximum of the equivalent of US \$1,500.00 per annum is payable, under certain conditions, in respect of each dependent child in full time attendance at a school or university.
- 5. Other main benefits in accordance with Staff Rules.—United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund and Group Life Insurance Plan (compulsory); medical scheme compulsory for experts and optional for dependants; Annual, home and sick leave;

Travel expenses on appointment, repatriation and home leave; installation and repatriation grant; transport of personal effects and household goods. Under certain conditions, these benefits are also applicable to recognized dependants.

Exonerations from taxation in respect of salary and allowances are the same as those enjoyed by officials of the United Nations.

ANNEX

IMPROVEMENT OF THE RIVER AND FLOOD FORECASTING AND WARNING SYSTEM FOR THE INDUS RIVER BASIN IN PAKISTAN

The purpose of this project, the first phase of which will have a duration of 3 years, is to establish a modern forecasting system for the Indus River Basin in Pakistan. This is to be achieved through the implementation of a large project which will have the following components:

Component I: Expansion and modernization of the basic hydrological data collection and processing system.

Component II: Establishment of a radar hydrology and a meteorological satallite read-out support system.

Component III: Establishment of a river and flood forecasting system.

Although the project is to be funded from different sources, (bi-lateral assistance for Component I and UNDP funds for Components II and III), it will be implemented as a single project. The three components of the project are inter-related and inter-dependent.

Component I will provide hydrometric observations and records of improved quality and ensure that these data are received by the Flood Warning Center in near-real-time. The component also provides for the streamflow routing model, an integral part of the forecasting model.

Component II (radar) will provide calculated amounts and a real distribution of precipitation from the headwaters area in Kashmir as well as track the progress and development of storms from India into the Upper Indus basin. This will improve the lead time of the forecasts for the "rim" stations by a minimum of 6 hours and a maximum of 36 hours, with an average of about 24 hours. The accuracy and reliability of the forecasts for downstream points as well as the "rim" stations will be improved because of the precise timing and a real distribution of rainfall supplied by radar.

Component III the forecasting system, will be the culmination of the comprehensive project. It includes the catchment (rainfall-runoff) model, hydrometeorological observing and reporting stations, training of counterpart river forecasters and the organization of all the necessary elements into a complete and functional system. This component is completely dependent upon the observation and data collection systems provided by Components I and II.
